ACCESSIBILITY

The Delacorte Theater offers stadium-style seating, with each row of seats higher than the row in front of it. <u>There are 18-34 steps involved to reach the captioning</u> section which is **not wheelchair accessible.** An assistive listening system is available.

The Delacorte Theater in Central Park is located near 80th St. at the southwest corner of the Great Lawn. The closest entrance to the park is at Central Park West and W. 81st St.
