AROUND THE GROUNDS - ROUND NO.3

The juniors had six wins and 8 losses in Round No.3 and currently stand in second place in the SSJCA Club Championship. Our 16A, 16B-1 and 10B sides are all still undefeated and there are a number of teams well placed in their respective competitions. Best performances this round came from intermediate player of the round Angus Brown who took 6 for 28 in his 16B-2 team's narrow loss to St Patricks and both 16B-1 batsmen Dylan Smith (52) and Josh Berry (51) scoring half centuries. Our joint junior players of the round put on two match winning efforts for their teams with Kye Robson (12D-1) 45 & 2 for 14 and Koby Lillis (10B) 27 not out & 2 for 7.

In this round both our under eight teams had their first loss of the season in matches that went down to the wire. In two low scoring matches only four players were able to score double figures with Koby Wallace (17), Corey Turner (15), Bailey Croker (12) and Benjamin Veitch (11) with the bowlers Luke Dowse, Corey Turner, Fred Morando and Elijah Dundas all taking one wicket each.

Round three proved successful for our senior sides with two losses, three byes and three wins, which included big wins to the B1-2 and C1 teams who claimed maximum points for the round. Best batting performances came from century makers Brayden Heffernan (B6) 140 and Triston McGuire (C1) 117 while Nathan Morando (B1-2) took 5 for 22 & 2 for 13. Current senior competition standings are as follows: A1 - Equal 2nd, A2 - 4th, B1-1 - 1st, B1-2 - 5th, B2 - 1st, B3 - Equal 3rd, B6 - 6th & C1 - 1st.
