

Statute of Limitation Request Form

Requirement:

Students who have courses on their transcript which were credited five years or more prior to the start date of the earliest course taken to be counted toward the degree shall at any time prior to graduation be allowed to appeal to the Registrar (or designate) to have grades for all such courses forfeited.

If granted permission to do so, all courses listed on the student's transcript will remain; however grades for the set of courses to which the Statute of Limitations applies will be removed (except in the case of grades of "F Academic Dishonesty") and replaced by the notation WSL (withdrew Under Statute of Limitations) and the following notation will be placed on their transcripts:

"Having discontinued attendance for a period of five years or more prior to the start date of the earliest courses taken to be used for the degree, and having successfully appealed to the Registrar (or designate), this student has been allowed to forfeit all such previous credits and such courses are designated WSL (Withdrew Under Statute of Limitations) and all such credits are forfeited."

Students on campus should submit the completed form to the Office of the Associate Registrar (Rm. 117, Main Floor, and A.E. McKenzie Bldg).
