November 9th, 2004

Topics Soaring Variometer, Flight Recorder and Flight Computer Comparisons PLUS 2005 Region 7 Contest

Details Overwhelmed by the many options for variometers, flight recorders and soaring flight computers available today? This talk features brief overviews of all the available products and includes comparison tables of each product type. Examples of complete systems incorporating flight computers and Pocket PCs will also be discussed. In addition, Paul is the contest manager of the upcoming 2005 Region 7 contest to be held in Albert Lea, Minnesota (near Minneapolis) and will discuss the event. The Contest Director will be Charlie Spratt.

Biography Paul Remde has been flying gliders since 1990. He is a very technical person who loves talking about soaring, badge flying, soaring instruments, GPSs, Pocket PCs, etc and runs Cumulus Soaring Inc. He is knowledgeable on badge, record, contest and aerobatic flying, and ready to help you select and use the right instruments and software for your soaring needs. He holds all the FAI Badge legs for the Bronze, Silver, Gold and Diamond badges - with the exception of the altitude gain legs. Paul has flown in 3 soaring contests, acted as Competition Director at one contest, and has earned 6 Minnesota state soaring records. He is also the Minnesota state soaring record keeper. Paul has owned

several sailplanes including a Schempp-Hirth Ventus b and a Schweizer 1-35c.

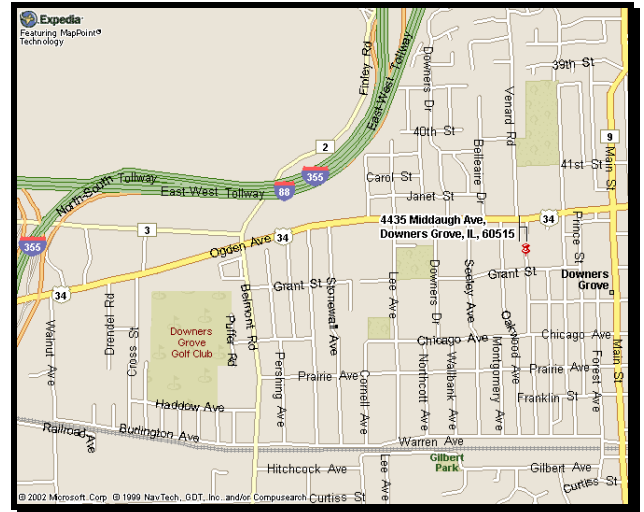
