# Important rules, regulations and deadlines

Your application must be with the IMC University of Applied Sciences Krems by <u>May 1<sup>st</sup> for the fall term</u> / by <u>November 1<sup>st</sup> for the spring term</u>.

- All EU-citizens must have the relevant <u>insurance document</u> students from all other countries must have a <u>valid international insurance policy</u> (copy must be provided upon arrival).
- You must have a <u>very good knowledge of English (at least B2)</u> in order to carry out your studies for the degree programmes Export-Oriented Management, International Business & Export Management, Tourism & Leisure Management, Marketing & Sales and Medical & Pharmaceutical Biotechnology (DOUBLE DEGREE Students must have at least level C1!).
- For the **all other degree programmes** your <u>German</u> must be very good as well (nearly all lectures in German!).

The IMC University of Applied Sciences Krems reserves the right to terminate your stay if you fail to meet the minimum academic standards or if you are found in violation of the laws and regulations of Austria or the IMC University of Applied Sciences.

# **Checklist for International Exchange Students**

## Your application file must comprise:

- 1. Application form
- 2. Accommodation form

- Passport copy
   Copy of health insurance policy
   Copy of Secondary School Leaving Certificate OR General University Entrance Qualification
   Copy of Bachelor Diploma OR equivalent (only for Master students!)
- 7. Copy of all trancripts already received during previous semesters at the home university (only for Double Degree students!)

\*All International Exchange Students have to hand in a PROVISIONAL learning agreement together with their application documents. From September 1<sup>st</sup> (fall term) / February 1<sup>st</sup> (spring term) onwards, all students have to compose their FINAL learning agreement according to the course schedule and have to hand it in at the Academic Mobility Programmes' Office of the IMC University of Applied Sciences Krems within a given deadline.

# EU citizens

In case you are moving to Krems for your studies you are obliged to register at the "Meldeamt der Stadt Krems" at the City Hall within 3 days after your arrival.

#### The following documents are necessary for a successful registration:

- Registration form with the signature of your landlord ("Meldezettel") •
- Passport •
- Birth certificate •
- Certificate of marriage, divorce decree or equivalent .

When staying in Austria for more than 3 months it is additionally necessary to register within 3 months at the "Fremdenpolizei" (Pfarrplatz 2, 3500 Krems).

### The following documents are necessary for a successful registration:

- Passport
- ID photo
- Certificate of health insurance (insurance card or policy)
- A statement of funds (bank statement)
- 15 € registration fee
- Exchange students need to bring the confirmation of Exchange student's status issued by the IMC University of Applied Sciences Krems
- Regular students also need their enrolment certification

## **NON EU Citizens**

NON EU citizens have to fulfill the same requirements as EU citizens moving to Austria from outside of Austria.

Before travelling to Austria it is necessary to obtain a **Visa from the Austrian representation** in the student's home country. Regarding special Visa requirements please check the "Guide to entry and residence requirements for foreign students" of the OEAD (<u>www.oead.at</u>).

Please note that after expiry of your Visa you will no more be allowed to travel within the Schengen area. And without the registration at the Magistrat and the permit of residence you are considered as illegally staying in Austria and will eventual face legal action and have to leave the country.
