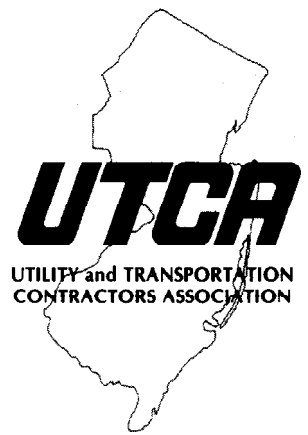


ANNOUNCING UTCA'S ANNUAL COMPREHENSIVE CONSTRUCTION SAFETY SEMINAR

The new law applies to any "power-operated hoisting machine used in construction, demolition or excavation work that has a power-operated winch, load line and boom moving laterally by the rotation of the machine on a carrier and has a manufacturer-rated lifting capacity of ten tons or more."

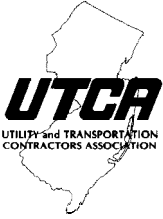

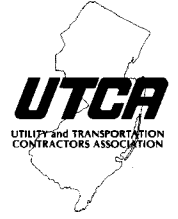
