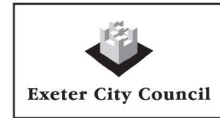

BP Portrait Award: Next Generation Spring School

Information

RAMM invites applications from young people aged 14 to 19 to apply for a place on its *BP Portrait Award: Next Generation* Spring Art School. It is two days long.

The Spring School at RAMM is part of *BP Portrait Award: Next Generation*, a project now in its third year, inspired by the London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games. The project encourages 14 to 19 year olds to become involved in painted portraiture through the *BP Portrait Award 2012*.

The *BP Portrait Award: Next Generation* Spring School runs on Thursday 4 April and Friday 5 April 2013 10.30am to 4.00 pm.

Applications close: Friday 8 March 2013

Who:

- 14 to 19 year olds interested in art and especially portraiture

What:

- An intensive two-day workshop exploring creative approaches to portraiture
- Working with professional artists, including past BP Portrait Award winning artists
- Generating a body of work through artist-led workshops, presentations and ice-breaker activities
- Viewing and responding to the *BP Portrait Award 2012* exhibition touring to RAMM, developing skills, including painting and drawing from life
- Meeting other young people interested in art
- The *BP Portrait Award: Next Generation* Spring School runs on Thursday 4 and Friday 5 April 10.30am to 4.00 pm
- A celebration event for participants and their families/supporters will be on Friday 5 April at 3.00pm
- Applicants must ensure they can attend both complete days of the *BP Portrait Award: Next Generation* Spring School
- Activities will take place in Meeting Rooms A and B, RAMM, Queen Street, Exeter EX4 3RX 01392 265858

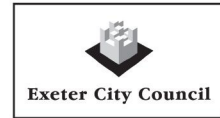
Application Guidance

- Entry is by application using the form on the following pages of this document
- Applications are accepted on the strength of the Artist Statement in the Application Form – we recommend applicants put time into this section of the form.
- Please do not attach or include sketches or other artworks
- There are 16 places and demand for these will be extremely high. Applicants must commit to attending both days of the Spring School. If applicants fail to turn up on time or do not attend both days, their place may be given to another applicant.
- Applicants must be aged between 14 and 19 years old at the time of the Spring School.
- Places are FREE and all art materials and refreshments are included
- Please indicate on the form if you live more than 10 miles from Exeter and keep your receipts for travel as we may be able to help with transport costs
- Spring School participants and their artworks will be photographed and filmed and you will be asked to sign a form for give permission for this (see later in this document).
