Dear Villa Hope Families:

We are excited for 2010! We hope that this year we will be able to place many waiting children from China and Peru with their forever families! We have started of 2010 with a Bang! Our Peru program continues to be a great success! We are so thankful to all of our families!

Pat Baldwin, Director of International Programs, will be traveling to Costa Rica at the end of February to meet with adoption officials and explore the possibility of setting up a new program.

Villa Hope opened a domestic program this year for both closed and open adoptions. We are looking for families willing to welcome African American or multi-racial newborn babies who are potentially at-risk. At this time we only plan to take a limited number of applicants for this pilot prgram. We are currently compiling an information packet for prospective adoptive families. Additionally, Villa Hope is able to help birth moms find the right family to provide a safe and loving home for the infant. We know that making an adoption plan for your child is difficult, that is why I and the Villa Hope staff are prepared to assist birth mothers 24 hours a day to help her through the entire process. China Waiting Children List

We have access to a database with hundreds of children ranging in age from 10 months – 9yrs old. We have children listed on our "Villa Hope" online list as well. Once your dossier is prepared, we are able to start looking to match you with a child that meets the needs you are willing to accept. Currently, there is a very short wait list and you potentially could be matched upon completion of dossier depending on sex and needs you are willing to accept. It is hard to estimate this as it will depend on sex, age and medical conditions you are open to. Wait time from matching you with a child to travel is currently 6 -8 months.

Adoption Tax Credit

As some of you may already know, the current adoption tax credit is set to expire in December of this year and return to the original amount of \$5,000 unless Congress approves to extend it. We are currently encouraging all of our families, as well as friends and family of adoptive families to write their Congressman and ask for them to vote for The Adoption Tax Relief Guarantee Act of 2009, H.R. 213. This legislation will help to make the tax credit more permanent. Below you will find information that we received from an online website that discusses the adoption credit and the process to write your Congressman in detail. You will also find a sample letter.



Instructions for writing your Congressman

Find the name and Washington, D.C. mailing address of your Representative and Senators at www.congress.org. To find e-mail addresses, click through to the Senator's or Congressperson's Web site.

Next, log on to http://thomas.loc.gov/ to find out whether your Congresspersons are already co-sponsors of the legislation. On the thomas.loc.gov opening page, under "Search Bill Summary and Status," search by bill number for Then click on "Bill summary and Status." On the page that comes up, click on "Cosponsors," "Text of Legislation," or "All Congressional Actions" to follow the progress of the bill.

If your representatives have not signed on as co-sponsors of the bill, send them your request that they do so. Tell them how important the tax credit was to you when you adopted your children, or how much you and other families you

know are counting on it to be available in the future. Emphasize that the tax credit truly results in more children finding homes. Tell them that this is so important to you that you will be following the bill's progress through Congress.

INCLUDE A FAMILY PHOTO: While e-mails are valuable, a written note with a picture of your family or your children will be most effective. If sending e-mail, you'll actually want to avoid attaching a photo; the large size of the message and the attachment could, potentially, mark it as junk or harmful e-mail. If any of your Congresspersons are already co-sponsors, write them a thank-you note. Again, letters sent by mail with photos of your children will receive more attention.

As you may know, adoption expenses can easily exceed \$20,000, a significant sum to most families. (Or, if your expenses were more, say so.)

I urge you to co-sponsor H.R. 213. This legislation is so important to me that I will be following its progress through Congress. Thank you in advance for your support of this legislation that truly serves children who need new families.



VILLA HOPE PROGRAMS



PERU:

This is Villa Hope's BIGGEST program! It appears that we may have as many as 40 applicants this year. Many of our families are adopting children with minor special needs, sibling groups, and healthy older children. We especially welcome Peruvian couples. Singles are allowed to adopt older children. Peru is a Hague country.

ETHIOPIA: This program is open and we are placing children ranging from infants, 2 unrelated children, siblings, and older children.

RUSSIA: Our Russia program is open and we are taking applicants at this time. The wait for a child under 24 months is approximatly months from the time your dossier is submitted! This program is open to single women.

CHINA:

Regular program

Currently, referrals have been sent for those families that have been logged in through March 28, 2006. Currently, the wait is reaching at least 48 months to receive a referral. At this time, we are unsure if the wait will increase or decrease.

Costa Rica:

This will be a new program in 2010. Pat Baldwin, Director of International Programs, will be traveling to find out more about the children available and the eligibility criteria for prospective adoptive families.

EL SALVADOR: Children above the age of 6 years are available from this country. Please contact Pat Baldwin, our Director of International Programs, at patbaldwin@villahope.org for more information.

It is getting more difficult for singles to adopt. The countries that are accepting applications are Kazakhstan and Russia who have infants and younger children available. Peru and Costa Rica are open for older children and sibling groups.
