Once the University submits a student's information to DHS for verification, this federal agency may have the legal right to share the information with other government agencies.

- By signing this application, I certify under penalty of perjury that I am either a U.S. citizen or a citizen of another country who is lawfully present within the U.S. I understand that my lawful presence within the US. will be verified through the Department of Homeland Security, prior to an award of this scholarship/financial aid.
