To Register

Register online at <u>www.4cforkids.org</u>, you will receive an email confirmation. To register via mail, print the registration form below and mail to 4-C, 1215 South Third St., Louisville, KY 40203. No confirmation will be sent. Registration deadline is noon, one business day before the class. A \$30.00 fee will be charged for all returned checks.

Training Record Information System (TRIS)

TRIS is the state-wide system designed to store and maintain individual training records for all early care and education professionals in Kentucky. All training participants will be asked to complete an ECE-TRIS form. To print a PDF copy of the TRIS form from the 4-C website, www.4cforkids.org, select Child Care Professionals, then select Posters, Forms & Resources.

CEUs Available

Continuing Education Units are available for most trainings. CDA renewal requires 4.5 CEUs, which is the equivalent of 45 clock hours of training over 3 years. CEUs must be requested and paid for at the time of registration. CEUs cannot be back dated...so plan ahead!

Friendly Reminder

Participants arriving 10 minutes late or leaving 10 minutes early are ineligible to receive a training certificate.

Cancellation Policies

Cancellations made at least 48 hours in advance will be issued credit for other 4-C training. Please note that no refunds will be issued. Inclement weather or extenuating circumstances may cancel the class. If fewer than 10 participants are registered, 4-C may choose to reschedule or cancel. Participants will be notified within 3 days of the cancellation and given the option to attend another class, attend the rescheduled class, or credit will be issued. All credits must be used by December 31 of the current year.

Accommodations

We are unable to accommodate children and unregistered participants during workshops. If you are bringing an interpreter with you, please indicate it on your registration form. All sites are handicap accessible. The 4-C Central Office has a ramp in the rear of the building.
