Dear Parent/Guardian and Student,

In the best interest of the school administration, students, faculty, parents, and the Souhegan High School Board, the Community Council has adopted the following policy regarding off-campus privileges and responsibilities for Souhegan Students:

- 1. Beginning Monday, September 9th, off-campus privileges will be extended to students in grades 11 and 12 who have a signed parental form on file in the attendance office, have maintained good behavior, and:
 - a) have earned effort grades of all 3's and above based on their previous trimester assessment.
 OR
 - b) have earned grades of all "C's" or above based on their previous trimester assessment.
- 2. Students will be required to present their school ID card to the campus monitor <u>each time</u> they leave campus. NO STUDENT WILL BE ALLOWED TO LEAVE CAMPUS WITHOUT PRESENTING ACCEPTABLE IDENTIFICATION.

Students in grades 11 and 12 who do not meet the above criteria may petition for privileges through the Dean of Students. Students who meet the above criteria in trimester 3 of their 10th grade year are eligible for off-campus privileges in the 1st trimester of their 11th grade year. The school retains the right to revoke off-campus privileges or parking privileges for students who violate the stated policy. <u>Students who violate the substance abuse policy will have their off campus privileges revoked.</u> A campus monitor will help ensure consistent policy enforcement. Repeated violation from the school community will result in a closed campus.
