



# Job Hazard Analysis (JHA) Form

**EXAMPLE #1**

<i>Job Title:</i> <b>Metal Shop Worker</b>	<i>Job Location:</i> <b>Metal Shop</b>	<i>Analyst:</i> <b>Joe Safety</b>	<i>Date:</i> <b>02/23/2019</b>
<i>Task Description:</i> <b>Worker reaches into metal box to the right of the machine, grasps a 15-pound casting and carries it to grinding wheel. Worker grinds 20 to 30 castings per hour.</b>			
<i>Hazard Type:</i> <b>Physical Injury</b>	<i>Hazard Description:</i> <b>Picking up a casting, the employee could drop it onto his foot. The casting's weight and height could seriously injure the worker's foot or toes.</b>		
<i>Consequence:</i> <b>Seriously injured foot</b>	<i>Hazard Control:</i> <b>1. Remove castings from the box and place them on a table next to the grinder 2. Wear steel-toe shoes with arch protection. 3. Change protective gloves that allow a better grip. 4. Use a device to pick up castings.</b>

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## EXAMPLE #3

<i>Job Title:</i> <b>Sanitation Worker</b>	<i>Job Location:</i> <b>Growing</b>	<i>Analyst:</i> <b>Joe Safety</b>	<i>Date:</i> <b>02/23/2019</b>
<i>Task Description:</i> <b>Employee mixes verticide chemical solution to perform sanitation tasks.</b>			
<i>Hazard Type:</i> <b>Chemical Injury</b>	<i>Hazard Description:</i> <b>Skin - Severe skin irritant, prolonged or repeated contact may cause dermatitis. Eyes – Severe eye irritant. Liquid and mists may injure the eyes, causing corneal damage. Ingestion – May be irritating to the mouth, throat, and gastrointestinal system. Burning, pain, and diarrhea expected with large doses.</b>		
<i>Consequence:</i> <b>Severe irritation to the skin, eyes and ingestion system.</b>	<i>Hazard Control:</i> <b>1. Use water proof protective gloves 2. Face shield when handling concentrate 3. Provide local exhaust to keep TVL ingredients below acceptable limits.</b>
