Participants anticipating delay in forwarding their application may send an advance copy directly to the Course Director through E-mail and bring no objection certificate at the time of joining the short course. Each participant will be required to deliver a seminar highlighting his/ her activities in their parent organization and also to provide a feedback on the course. A certificate will be awarded to the participants on the successful completion of the Short course.

#### **Course Objectives**

Communication technologies have been very well recognized for their significant role in sustainable economic development all across the world. The increasing significance and visible impact of Hybrid communication tools in communication of latest technologies, technical knowhow, wealth-creation and employment-generation has been accepted globally as the engine of economic growth. The communication methods & tools, if used appropriately have tremendous potential to improve agricultural production scenario in the socio-economic development of the country. The short course, therefore, is aimed to provide an opportunity to the participants to obtain hands-on training on hybrid communication methods as a tool for improved technology transfer in agriculture sector towards empowering Indian farmers. The training programme will consist of lectures, group discussions and practical sessions on hybrid information communication tools viz extension through Personal Digital Assistants & Smart phone/phablet applications, developing interactive communication tools, Participatory Educational Aids for rural communication, Electronic learning and diagnostic modules, SMS based knowledge exchange through Mobile telephony, Voice KVK service for farmers, multiple uses of ICT tools in communication and extension management, Media mix and its importance, developing web portal, Data digitalization & video conferencing etc in agricultural sector.

# Eligibility

Candidates holding the rank of Scientist/ Assistant Professor and above or equivalent in the National Agricultural Research System (NARS) including SAUs/SVUs, DUs, CUs, KVKs, Agricultural and Allied Science Faculties of other Universities possessing Master's or Doctoral degree in Extension Education or any other related disciplines including Veterinary/Animal Sciences are eligible to apply for the Short course. Only 25 participants will be selected for the course by a Screening Committee as per ICAR guidelines. The selected participants will have to pay Rs. 50/- as registration fee at the time of their registration in the Summer School.

#### **Boarding and Lodging**

The participants will be reimbursed to and fro travel fare by shortest rail (AC II tier) / road route as per ICAR norms on production of valid travel documents. Outstation participants will be provided free boarding and lodging at the institute guest house. The weather in Bareilly in the month of October will be pleasant, temperature ranging from 20 to  $30^{0^{\circ}}$ .

### Travel

Bareilly city is almost equidistant from New Delhi and Lucknow, well connected to major cities of India by rail and road. The railway station and bus stand of the city are approximately 8 and 5 km, respectively from the Institute. Izatnagar is approachable from Bareilly and Izatnagar railway stations by taxi, auto-rickshaw or cycle-rickshaw.
