NORTH WEST COMPANY FALL GATHERING

INFORMATION PACKET

What is expected of participants (volunteer interpreters): The primary focus of the Fall Gathering® is the portrayal of Minnesota's rich fur trade history between 1700 to 1830. We encourage friendly personal contact with each visitor.

Behavior: Domestic disputes, thievery, fighting and other inappropriate behavior will result in a request for your departure and possibly summoning the local authorities. Please conduct yourself and your business in a non-offensive manner. Parents are responsible for their children's behavior and should be accompanied by them when visiting the fur post or visitor center. Repeat problems will result in a request for your departure.

Black Powder: The only firing of arms will take place during flintlock reliability contest. **Camping:** Primitive camping only. There are no facilities for modern tents or RV's **Clothing:** Historic costume must be worn at all times on the Historic site.

Fires: Fires are permitted but must be contained within a pit. Please save the sod. When you leave, please re-fill the pit, replace the sod and water it. Campfires must not be left unattended at any time. Each campsite should ensure that someone is in attendance while a fire is burning. In addition, each campsite is responsible for having at least one of the following:

- a bucket of water near the fire pit OR - a bucket of sand near the fire pit OR- a fire extinguisher (hidden but nearby)

Firewood: Hauling wood from the pile is permitted by hand only. Please return unused wood to the pile.

<u>High Wines:</u> Consumption of alcoholic beverages is NOT PERMITTED during the Fall Gathering®.

Parking: There is a designated parking area for Gathering Participants. Please request directions and a parking pass when registering.

Pets: No pets allowed.

Quiet Hours: Midnight to 7:00 a.m. is designated as quiet hours.

Setup: Early setup begins at noon on Wednesday. Please note that the camp is closed to vehicle traffic on Saturday 9:30 am to Sunday at 4:15 pm.

<u>Traders:</u> All traders must comply with the requirements. You must register and obtain approval from the Quality Control Committee prior to trading/selling. The QCC will be reviewing all trade goods Saturday morning; they have the right to ask you to remove any unacceptable items.

Quality Control Specification: Will be sent to all registered traders and food purveyors. **Justices of the Peace:** Several appointed Justices of the Peace will be on site to help remind us that this is a Historic Gathering on a State Historic Site.
