HUMANE AGENT TRAINING: MARCH 2013

HA training is for applicants who county humane societies intend to appoint as humane agents within their county. Humane Agent appointments must be made by county humane societies organized under section 1717.05 of the Ohio Revised Code and they must be approved by the mayor of the municipal corporation where the appointment is made. If the humane society exists outside of a municipal corporation, such appointments shall be approved by the probate judge of the county where the appointment is made.

Registration forms for Humane Agent training must be signed by the director/CEO of the county humane society where the applicant resides. If there is no director/CEO in your county, then this application must be signed by the president of the board of directors of the county humane society. In the absence of either of those positions, this application must be signed and approved by the president of the Ohio Federated Humane Societies in order to take the training. Other individuals who are empowered to enforce Ohio's animal cruelty laws (police officers, sheriff's, dog wardens, etc.) may take the training at the discretion of the director/CEO in the county where they reside.
