CONTINUING EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP COMPETITION SPRING OF 2010

All applications must be submitted by April 17, 2010

Latinos Unidos del Norte announces a Partnership Scholarship competition for students who value their cultural heritage and plan to continue their studies in the fall of 2010. The Latinos Unidos del Norte will award a \$500 scholarship in partnership with a one-year tuition award from the President of the University of Alaska.

Applicants must meet the following requirements to qualify:

- **1.** Be enrolled on any campus of the University of Alaska system (University o Alaska Fairbanks, University of Alaska Anchorage or University of Alaska Southeast).
- 2. Agree to become a member and volunteer x hours to the Latinos Unidos del Norte to help raise funds for the following year's scholarship.
- 3. Be a lawful resident of the US, with at least two years of residency established in Alaska.
- **4.** Have at least a 2.5 grade point average.

Selection of Scholarship Recipient will be based upon:

- **1.** Value placed upon cultural heritage by the applicant.
- **2.** Intent of applicant to pursue a baccalaureate degree.
- **3.** Applicant's interest in community service and extra curricular activities.

Applicants Must Submit:

- 1. Two letters of recommendation addressing one or more of the selection criteria:
 - ⇒ One from a faculty member or advisor
 - ⇒ One from a community member
- 2. A typewritten essay of at least 250 words but no longer than one page addressing the value the applicant places on her/his cultural heritage.
- **3.** A brief description of the applicant's interests in pursuing a college degree.
- Scholarship application form for personal information, official transcript or other official verification of GPA.

The Terms of the Partnership Scholarship are as Follows:

- The President's Scholarship covers fall and spring undergraduate tuition. Latinos Unidos del Norte will contribute \$500 toward expenses directly related to attending college, such as room and board fees, books, student health, computer, or activity fees. Receipts are requested for IRS purposes.
- 2. Recipients of any other UA Presidential Scholarship (e.g. UA Scholar award) are not eligible for this scholarship.
- 3. The Scholarship may be used for **full-time** attendance at any main or extended campus of the University of Alaska system.
- 4. The recipient must maintain at least a 2.5 GPA for the duration of the scholarship.
- 5. Children of LUDN members (including the board of directors) are specifically <u>not</u> excluded from eligibility.

Recipients will be announced by the Latinos Unidos del Norte in May 2010 during the *Cinco de Mayo* celebration. Recipients will also be informed by mail by the University of Alaska President's Office.
