CALL FOR NOMINATIONS!

THE REGIONAL GERIATRIC PROGRAM OF TORONTO IS INVITING NOMINATIONS FOR THE RGP TEAM AWARD OF EXCELLENCE, RECOGNIZING THE EXCEPTIONAL ACHIEVEMENTS OF A TEAM IN THE RGP OF TORONTO NETWORK.

Purpose

The RGP Award of Excellence recognizes teams and partnerships contributing to improved health outcomes for frail seniors.

Eligibility

Nominees must be teams – comprised of two (2) or more people – within the RGP of Toronto network organizations.

Award Criteria

The winning team must demonstrate:

- Achievements in service, education, research, and/or advocacy in a way that significantly contributes to better health outcomes for seniors.
- Innovation and an enduring contribution to enhanced care for older adults.
- Teamwork and partnerships that advance interprofessional and /or inter-organizational practice, teamwork, and effective partnerships in the care of frail seniors.

Examples of achievements that would be considered include:

- Rallying interprofessional teams and volunteers for early mobilization initiatives with hospitalized seniors.
- Programs that look beyond traditional boundaries to build capacity among health system partners and advance continuity of care, such as nurse led LTC outreach initiatives.

Nominations will be reviewed by a panel that includes a member of the RGP Awards Committee, an RGP Board Member, and an affiliate Clinician or Academic.
