Important Information about Loop Abroad's 2012 "Plight of the Thai Elephant" Program

Cancellations, Itinerary Changes, and Refunds

Loop Abroad reserves the right to cancel, alter, reschedule, or amend any or all programs offered at any time. If a trip is cancelled by Loop Abroad prior to the beginning of that trip, Loop Abroad will refund all payments made by the applicant. If a trip is cancelled by Loop Abroad once it has begun, a portion of the applicant's total payments will be refunded. Once your application has been accepted, cancellation by you for any reason results in a penalty as follows: 1) cancellation by you before April 1*, 2012 results in a loss of 30% of your total tuition; 2) cancellation by you between April 1* and April 30*, 2012 results in a loss of 60% of your tuition; 3) cancellation by you between May 1* and June 1*, 2012 results in a loss of 75% of your tuition; 4) cancellation by you on or after June 1*, 2012 results in a loss of 100% of your total tuition. We encourage you to purchase travel insurance on the full cost of your trip if there is any chance that you may be unable to travel with us. The Application Fee and Confirmation of Participation Fee are non-refundable. Trip cancellation date is determined by the date we receive written notice by e-mail or mail indicating that a participant wishes to cancel his/her planned program.

Insurance

Loop Abroad provides basic travel insurance for our students, which provides minimal protection against baggage loss or theft and minor injuries. Parents or guardians must ensure that their son or daughter is fully covered for any medical expenses that may be incurred during the trip. Injuries do occur, and health insurance is mandatory for all participants. Loop Abroad will provide you with information about additional travel insurance

that includes medical insurance if your current insurance does not cover international care. Participants and their parents are responsible for any and all medical costs incurred before, during, or after a Loop Abroad trip regardless of the cause.

Liability Waivers, Releases, Medical Disclosures & Rules

Both participants and their parents or guardians will be required to sign and comply with various rules, liability waivers and releases prior to the beginning of Loop Abroad's summer program. Our trip includes airline flights, rafting, hiking, camping, interacting with elephants and tigers, travel in remote areas, and other potentially dangerous activities. Neither Loop Abroad nor its officers, directors, contractors, employees, agents or staff can guarantee against injuries or accidents that may occur for whatever reason on any trip. Participants will not be permitted to travel with Loop Abroad unless all required paperwork has been received before the program begins.

Passports and Visas

All participants require a passport valid through February 1*, 2013. You will be responsible for ensuring that you have the necessary passport, visa, and any other documents to enter Thailand, depending on your country of residence. You are responsible for bringing your passport to the airport with you at the start of our trip.

Expectations from Participants

Loop Abroad expects participants to be enthusiastic, cooperative and appreciative of the opportunities afforded to them through our programs. The use or possession of illegal drugs, tobacco, or alcohol is strictly forbidden on this program. Loop Abroad reserves the right to remove any student from any trip, at the student's expense, if a student uses drugs, alcohol or tobacco, endangers the lives of him/herself or others, commits any crime, is disruptive of or unwilling to participate in activities, endangers his/her own safety or the safety of others, or consistently disregards staff instructions.

International Travel Costs

We will negotiate a group flight rate from Boston, MA. Participants will be responsible for paying for this airfare to travel with us as a group to Thailand; this airfare is not included in tuition.

International Exchange Rates

Loop Abroad operates its program in Thailand and pays for most of the program in Thailand. Should the value of the US dollar decrease and thereby increase or operating costs for the program, we reserve the right to increase our program price in proportion with the change in the value of the US dollar and invoice you for this increase in costs.

Application Fee and Payments

An application fee of \$50 is due with this application. This fee is refundable only if the program to which you apply is full. Your \$1,000 non-refundable Confirmation of Participation fee is due within 30 days of your acceptance to the program. Your first payment of \$1,900 is due by March 12th. Your second payment of \$2,950 is due by April 30th. All late payments will incur a \$50 late payment charge. Loop Abroad reserves the right to cancel a student's place or reservation if payments are not made on time.
