

School Kits to be Collected at Annual Conference

During Annual Conference 2014 in a partnership ministry with NC Conference United Methodist Women and the Missions Team, we will be collecting school kits. Annual Conference is June 11-14, 2014 at the Greenville Convention Center.

Half of the kits will remain in our Annual Conference and half will be sent to worldwide mission sites.

You must build the kits as outlined below to meet UMCOR standard.

Assembly & Shipping Instructions

School Kit Materials

- 1) pair blunt scissors
 - Rounded tip only;
 - No plastic scissors please.
- 3) pads of paper
 - Spiral- or top-bound pads;
 - 150 sheets or less of loose-leaf paper can be substituted for 1 pad;
 - Combinations of spiral, top-bound, side-bound, or loose-leaf paper is acceptable.
- 1) hand-held pencil sharpener
 - Must be at least 1" long;
 - Remove from packaging.
- 1) 30-centimeter ruler
 - Hard or flexible;
 - Cartoon characters are acceptable;
 - No advertisements please.
- 6) unsharpened pencils
 - No advertisements, religious, patriotic, military, or camouflage symbols please;
 - Cartoon characters are acceptable.
- 1) 2-inch or larger-size eraser
 - No advertisements, religious, patriotic, military, or camouflage symbols please;
 - Cartoon characters are acceptable.
- 1) 24-count box of crayons
 - Only 24-count boxes please.
- 1) 14" x 16" cloth bag
 - Homemade or purchased bags are both acceptable;
 - Heavy-duty fabric only, such as denim, corduroy, drapery fabric, etc.;
 - No advertisements, religious, patriotic, military, or camouflage symbols please;
 - Closures are optional but must be buttons, snaps, or Velcro sewn in middle of opening.

If You Believe in Jesus Christ, You Are an Evangelist

At St. Andrews we have tried different types of evangelism. In 2000 we utilized Dr. James Kennedy's Evangelism Explosion to provide members with the tools for going door to door within the community to share the news of salvation through the gospel. Our next evangelism program, facilitated by Katie Jenifer, was a class called Just Walk Across the Room by Bill Hybels. We found this a better way of promoting evangelism and bringing the opportunity to show Christ to others.

Evangelism is connecting one-on-one, sharing your testimony and talking about your walk with God whenever the opportunity presents itself. In Isaiah 49:6 we are told "I will give you a light (Jesus Christ) to the nations, that my salvation may reach to the end of the earth". However, the Good News of salvation will not reach very far if we are not comfortable talking about our faith and our salvation. When we have the opportunity to minister to people, it is our responsibility as Christians to lead them into a relationship with Christ.

In the book The Master Plan of Evangelism by Robert Coleman, he suggests that we evangelize the way Jesus did. As Evangelism Coordinator, **I am inviting you to join me on Monday, May 5th at 6:30 pm**, in room 201. (Fellowship Classroom) We will talk about how Jesus evangelized and how we can do what He directed us to and follow in His footsteps.
