### Subject Verb Agreement Practice

Having subject and verb agreement means matching singular subjects with the singular form of the verb, and matching plural subjects with the plural form of the verb.:

The **boy walks** home from school. *(since boy is singular, use a singular verb)*

The **puppies are** cute. *(since puppies is plural, use a plural verb)*
