2. The **hard copy** of this **completed and physically signed application form** should be returned to the **Global Student Programs Office** together with your visa application documents, which would then be forwarded to the Student Housing and Residential Life Office for processing.
3. Each applicant is allowed to submit only **ONE** application; applicant found submitting more than one application will be disqualified without notice.
4. Deadline of application: **22 May 2015**
5. Result notification : **By End of July 2015**
6. Unless with the certification of the School of study here at HKUST that the applicant's exchange program will be extended beyond 30 December 2015; otherwise, all exchange students are required to check out of the student halls before **12 noon on 30 December 2015**.
7. Applicant will not eligible for student housing if the applicant ceases to be an exchange-in student. Any associated hall application, hall offer and hall residence will become null and void.
8. Applicant should take the residential period into account when planning your flights to and from Hong Kong or arrange other sources of accommodation on your own if you are going to stay in Hong Kong before or after the above-mentioned residential period. **No requests for early check-in or late check-out will be entertained.**
