#### 2009 Connecticut Yankee Council Instructions

- 1. Any registered Scouter affiliated with the Connecticut Yankee Council, Inc., may submit the name of any other male or female Scouter registered with this Council, as a candidate for this award.
- 2. Nominations must be received in the office of the Connecticut Yankee Council, PO Box 32, Milford, CT 06460-0032, Attention: Dan Cooley, no later than November 21, 2008. This will allow for proper screening by the Council's Selection Committee, preparation of national nomination forms, and subsequent review by the National Court of Honor prior to the Council's Annual Recognition Dinner.
- 3. This nomination is good for this year only. If the nominee fails to receive the award, it will be necessary to recommend him/her in the following year with a new and updated nomination form. Last year's nomination will not be provided to the selection committee. There is no limit as to the number of times a Scouter may be recommended for the award.
- 4. Under Scouting category regarding the nominee's background, please indicate a title of position(s) held, calendar years in position, unit type, unit number, and district name. List all positions chronologically with current position on top of list. This award is for adult service and it is not necessary to provide a list of activities related to nominee's youth record in Cub Scouting, Boy Scouting, or Exploring.
- 5. List any and all service to church/synagogue, civic and philanthropic organizations, professional and fraternal organizations. Community service in support of youth development is important for consideration of the nomination.
- 6. Detail any and all special activities that will enhance this nominee's recommendation. Enclosures in support of the nominations should accompany the recommendation. Supporting document will not be accepted after November 22, 2008.
- 7. Nominations cannot be made for posthumous awards.
