



Day 1 - Arrive in Cape Town

Meet and Greet services upon arrival at Cape Town Airport and road transfer to the Pepper Club Luxury Hotel & Spa. The afternoon and evening can be spent at leisure, and tonight enjoy a Deluxe Suite at your 5 star hotel.

Day 2 - Cape Town Tour

After breakfast at your hotel, enjoy a full day tour of the Cape Winelands. You will also experience the rich historical and cultural heritage of Cape Town, while visiting Paarl Franshhoek and Stellenbosch. We will stop for a wine tasting and picnic lunch at Allee Bleue Wine Estate in Franshhoek today, after which we will return to the hotel in the late afternoon. Day 3 – Everything Cape Town

Today commence on a full day tour of the Cape Peninsula. Our first stop is at Table Mountain, the iconic and picturesque backdrop to this beautiful city. Enjoy a ride up the Table Mountain Cable Car, stopping



at the top for a stunning view of Cape Town. Afterwards we head for Hout Bay, once a fishing community and now one of the most popular residential areas, the harbor still has the charm of days gone by. Travel onwards until we reach Cape Point and the Cape of Good Hope which offers magnificent views of the ocean. We now continue alongside the ocean and stop to see the Jackass penguin colony which has become well established at Boulder's Beach near Simon's Town. Next we stop for lunch, which will be at your own account. After lunch we travel back to Cape Town via Kalkbay, a trendy fishing village. Arrive at your hotel in the late afternoon, and relax for the rest of the day.

Day 4 – Cape Town - Hoedspruit - Greater Kruger National Park

Today you will embark in the early morning from your hotel to Cape Town Airport. On arrival you will board your flight to Hoedspruit. After landing you will be transferred to Imbali Safari Lodge in Kruger National Park, an exclusive lodge in this world renowned park. Imbali Safari Lodge continues the safari tradition of a bygone era, offering accommodations in spacious, private chalets each furnished in understated luxury overlooking the N'waswitsontso riverbed. The lodge is the central point on the Imbali Safari concession, and features some of the most experienced rangers in Kruger. Game drives are in open 4x4 vehicles with experienced rangers in the morning and late afternoon. Meal and activity times will be advised upon your arrival to the lodge, all are included.

Day 5 And Day 6 – Imbali Safari Lodge in Kruger National Park

Wake up early this morning and enjoy coffee, tea and snacks before embarking on your morning game drive. Try and spot the big 5 - lion, elephant, water-buffalo, rhino and the elusive leopard. Be sure to bring your camera, and be prepared for the experience of a lifetime. The staff at Imbali Safari Lodge is extremely experienced, and will show you the animals while educating you on their natural habitat. After your game drive, we will return to the lodge for a delicious breakfast, and then you will have free time to take a swim at the lodge, or relax and enjoy a beverage in your chalet. Lunch will be served following your free time, and then an afternoon tea or coffee will precede your afternoon game drive. Return to the lodge for dinner, and get some rest for your early morning game drive tomorrow.

Day 7 - Imbali Safari Lodge Day Three

This morning enjoy an early morning coffee, tea, and snack before embarking upon another game drive. After seeing as much wildlife as possible, you will return to the lodge for breakfast. After breakfast we will take you to Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport where you will board your scheduled flight to O.R. Tombo International airport (cost of flight not included). On arrival you will be transferred to the Fire & Ice Melrose Arch Protea Hotel, a four star property situated within walking distance of various shops and restaurants. This afternoon is free for you to enjoy at your leisure.



Day 8 - Johannesburg - Victoria Falls

After breakfast at your hotel, you will be transferred to O.R. Tambo International Airport. On Arrival you will connect onto your scheduled flight to Victoria Falls (cost of scheduled flight not included. After clearing customs and immigration (you will require a double entry visa) you will be transferred to your 5 star hotel, the Victoria Falls Safari Lodge. Enjoy an afternoon sundowner cruise on the Zambezi Explorer before enjoying an evening at your own leisure.

Day 9 – Enjoy Victoria Falls - Adventure Day

This morning enjoy breakfast at your lodge, before taking a morning tour of the astounding world heritage site, Victoria Falls. Day at leisure to enjoy any of the various activities offered in and around Victoria Falls. Victoria Falls is the home of adventure, and we would be happy to add any of the following activities to your tour for a small additional cost:

Day 10 -Victoria Falls - Chobe National Park

Enjoy breakfast at your lodge this morning. Next we will transfer you to Mowana Safari Lodge. You will clear customs and immigration into Botswana en-route. The lodge is situated on the banks of the Chobe River close to Chobe National Park, renowned for its vast herds of elephant and buffalo. The Kwando, Linyanti and Chobe River systems form a mosaic of lakes, islands, channels, and gloodplains and Chobe National Park is part of this system offering great wildlife viewing. Check in and enjoy lunch at your lodge, and then enjoy an exquisite game drive in Chobe National Park. Tonight you will enjoy a wonderful dinner at your lodge before resting for tomorrow's game cruise and drive.

Day 11 - Chobe National Park

Today enjoy breakfast at your lodge, before being escorted on a game cruise on the Chobe River. Take in the scenery and the vast array of wildlife as you float with experienced rangers down this world famous river. After your game cruise you will have lunch at your lodge, before heading back out on an afternoon game drive to explore Chobe National Park. Dinner will be served upon returning, and then you will have the evening to relax and enjoy your surroundings.

Day 12 - Back to Johannesburg

After breakfast you will be transferred to the airport where you will board your scheduled flight to Johannesburg (flight not included in cost). Board your scheduled flight home.


The Pool Deck on the 8th floor is the perfect place to relax and enjoy panoramic views of the city and mountains. Light lunches are served on the pool deck from November to March.


Guests can relax on the terrace, swim in the pool or just have a walk in the garden.

Mowana Safari Lodge



Mowana Safari Lodge lies on the banks of the Chobe river, where four African countries (Botswana, Zambia, Namibia and Zimbabwe) meet. At this point the Chobe and Zambezi rivers converge – the Zambezi river being the home of the NyamiNyami (or river god). So if you want to learn more about African myths and legends, the Chobe area around the Mowana Safari Lodge is the place to visit!

The Chobe Game Reserve is famous for its enormous elephant population – it is said that 45 000 of these interesting creatures roam the plains of Chobe. They share the area of almost 10 000 square kilometers with lion, leopard, giraffe, cheetah, buffalo, approximately 450 bird species, as well as puku and Chobe bushbuck, which are indigenous to Chobe National Park.

The luxurious Cresta Mowana Safari Resort & Spa near the Chobe Game Reserve is a four-star establishment. Guests are accommodated in 112 luxury rooms and 4 suites (all en suite and airconditioned).

All rooms and suites face the Chobe river and are equipped with tea/coffee-making facilities, ceiling fans, mini bars, hairdryers as well as mosquito nets and electric insect repellants. Rooms and suites at the Cresta Mowana Safari Resort & Spa also have satellite television and direct dial phone.
