

Leadership Hall County Nominations Class of 2012-2013

The Greater Hall Chamber Leadership Hall County program provides a learning experience for existing and emerging leaders of the Greater Hall area. Participants of the program are given the opportunity to develop an understanding of Gainesville and Hall County. Participants include a cross-section of individuals and must be 25 years old. Participants develop knowledge of the community through a series of one-day sessions, August through April. Participants are introduced during the Greater Hall Chamber Gala scheduled for May 10, 2012. An introduction session has been scheduled for June 14, 2012 from 1:00 – 4:00 followed by a social ending at 5:15. Topics covered include quality of life, education, health and social services, city and state governments, judicial, and economic development.

Tuition for each participant is \$800 for Chamber members and \$970 for non-Chamber members, which includes a one-year Chamber membership. Each participant is responsible for paying his/her own tuition. Fees are used to cover materials, monthly program expenses, Eggs and Issues Breakfast, annual retreat, graduation reception and plaque.

Individuals must be nominated for the program by March 15, 2012 using the form below. Once an applicant is nominated, he or she will be asked to complete a detailed application. All applicants are reviewed by a selection committee and final participants are selected from all applications submitted.
