This is a written request by a CONSULTANT for a health care service to be provided for a PATIENT, including the analysis of samples as part of PATIENT treatment. Such requests can be written or verbal.

A type of WRITTEN REFERRAL REQUEST.

This is a written request by a General Medical or Dental Practitioner for a health care service to be provided for a PATIENT. Such requests can be written or verbal.

The attributes and relationships are unchanged

GPFH REFERRAL TYPE

The classification of the contractual invoicing arrangement under which a GP FUNDHOLDER makes a WRITTEN REFERRAL REQUEST.

Classification:

- a. Cost per case contract
- b. Cost and volume contract
- c. Zero cost and volume contract
- d. Block contract
- e. Non-attributable contract

The role a HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER undertakes with regard to a WRITTEN REFERRAL REQUEST made on behalf of a GP FUNDHOLDER.

ROLE TYPE IN GPFH REFERRAL

The classification of the role undertaken by a GENERAL PRACTITIONER in terms of a GP WRITTEN REFERRAL REQUEST made on behalf of a GP FUNDHOLDER.

Classification:

- a. Referring GP: The GENERAL MEDICAL PRACTITIONER directly making the referral.
- b. Supervising General Medical Practitioner: The GENERAL MEDICAL PRACTITIONER who at the time of the referral is supervising a NURSE or assistant GENERAL MEDICAL PRACTITIONER who makes the referral. The supervising GENERAL MEDICAL PRACTITIONER may or may not be the GENERAL MEDICAL PRACTITIONER with whom the patient holds a current REGISTRATION.
- c. Trainee Present: A GENERAL MEDICAL PRACTITIONER REGISTRAR present when the referral was made.

This is a written request for a health care service to be provided for a PATIENT. <u>If there is a verbal request this</u> will normally be confirmed by a written request, and these should be processed as one referral. An electronic message is treated as a written referral.
