GO HEALTH GO GRIFFITH EXPERIENCE

Go Health Go Griffith invites schools to participate in the two day event. The program is designed for students so we can engage, enthuse, excite and allow the students to experience sessions in biology, physiology, health science, community, medicine, pharmacology, anatomy, molecular biology, clinical skills and public health and disability services and many exciting areas of health and science.

The laboratory sessions, tutorials, and clinical skills as well as resuscitation and infection control are all serviced by health professionals and or scientists from our University or Logan Health District. The collaborative effort enables the program to teach skills and engage over 100 participants.

Students have previously reported that the **Go Health Go Griffith** experience had an influence on their choice of subjects. Our data shows that after being provided with a snapshot of what can be experienced achieved and learnt was a positive influence in terms of expanding the scope of choices for students. Many students enrolled in biology and the sciences and or health effectively expanding their choices.

Due to the overwhelming positive response from schools, students and teachers as well as the educators from the sessions we have decided to extend this program to twice a year .This will enable more students to participate from a wider range of schools. *Positions are limited so get in quick*.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Parents/Guardian must sign student in and out on the days of attendance.

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WORKSHOP DETAILS

MICROSCOPY – **BUGS IN OUR BODY**: This session allows students to explore biology from a microscopic point of view and apply a clinical and scientific application for the identification and management of the bugs we encounter.

HUMAN ANATOMY: This session will be hands-on and students will have a tutorial on the body systems with the use of models, skills equipment and simulated material. Students can have fun while learning about science and its place in medicine.

BOUNCING BODIES: This session will be hands-on and requires the student to participate in some exercise physiology.

HEALTH PROMOTION AND ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE: This session is about the population, environmental health and the biological sciences.

DNA DISCOVERY: Students attend a laboratory class and extract DNA from various biological materials.

CLINICAL SKILLS AND LIFE SUPPORT: Students participate in real case scenarios and learn about life support.

COMMUNICATION FOR ALL OCCASIONS: Students become a health professional and educator which allows them to express themselves and expand their critical thinking skills.

BODIES BONES AND BITS: Students explore the possibilities and challenges in relation to adaptation, trauma and changes within the body.

MAKING MEDICINES: Students have the opportunity to work with a pharmacist and learn about medicine.

DENTISTRY: Students explore the world of dental techniques.



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STUDENT AND PARENT/GUARDIAN INFORMATION (to be retained by student and parent/guardian)

COST

All workshop materials and tuition for the duration of the workshop program will be included in the workshop fees. Griffith University will not provide for any costs associated with travel to or from the workshop.

FOOD AND DRINK

Students must bring their own lunch and drink. (There are no available food outlets on the campus during weekends). It is also recommended that students bring a water bottle. Morning tea (cordial, biscuits and fruit) will be provided. Students will be fully supervised whilst in the workshop and on breaks.

CLOTHING AND FOOTWEAR

Students may wear free dress, but footwear must be closed in.

MATERIALS

All materials will be provided in the workshop.

MOBILE PHONES

Mobile phones are permitted at the Go Health Go Griffith workshop. However, they must be turned off during the day but can be used for emergency calls to nominated emergency contacts

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

Arrival time should be no later than 15 minutes prior to the commencement of the workshop. The workshop will commence at 9:00 am and finish at 2:30 pm. On the day, please proceed to the registration desk outside Hub Link Building, LO7 (attached map reference C6) where students will be welcomed from 8.30 am. Students may be collected at 2:30 pm at the end of the workshop. If a parent or guardian is not collecting the student, written authorisation naming the person who will collect them must be provided by a parent/guardian.
