Community Members, S-VE Administration, and Former S-VE Graduates have established Graduates of Distinction recognition to honor Spencer Van Etten graduates for outstanding lifetime achievement. Honorees will be graduates who are exemplary citizens having distinguished themselves through their communities, professions or careers. This may include service to humanity, exceptional career achievement or a lifetime of accomplishment. Nominees may have succeeded at the local, regional, national or international levels in any appropriate area of endeavor, including academia and education, arts, business, media, public service, philanthropy, medicine, military, science or sports. The Board of Education may be petitioned to make an exception to these criteria if extraordinary circumstances exist. No person shall be eligible for this honor until at least ten years following the date of graduation from Spencer Van Etten. Nominations will be reviewed by a Superintendent's Committee and forwarded to the Board of Education for approval. Nominations must be received by July 1st. Incomplete nominations will not be considered. Recipients shall be permanently honored at Spencer Van Etten and shall be publicly recognized
