- •Prizes will be presented to the 1st overall male & female runners in the 5K & 10K Runs.
- •Awards will be presented to male and female 1st through 3rd place in each age group for both the 5K & 10K Runs.



- •Awards in the 5K Run will be grouped by race day age and gender in the following categories: 10 & under; 11-14; 15-19; 20-24; 25-29; 30-34; 35-39; 40-44; 45-49; 50-54; 55-59; 60-64; 65+
- •Awards in the 10K Run will be grouped by race day age and gender in the following categories: 14 & under; 15-19; 20-29; 30-39; 40-49; 50-59; 60+
- •Participants registered by April 29th will be guaranteed an event shirt.
- •Chip-timing mats will be positioned at both the start and finish
- •Those participating in the 5KRun and the 10K Run will be chiptimed. Recreational walkers will not be chip-timed.
- •The 5K award ceremony will begin at 9:00AM with the 10K awards to follow
- •All participants receive a finisher's medal
- •Entry Fee: \$25 Earlybird pricing until March 6th |\$30 March 7th- May 7th | \$35 May 8th - Race Day



Packet pick up is Friday, May 8th from 4:00 PM - 6:30 PM in the Healing Garden behind Kirby Medical Center. Race day parking will be available at the First Christian Church and Piatt County Nursing Home Service Drive on North State Street. Pets will not be permitted to participate in events. Bag check will not be available. Strollers will be permitted in the 5K/10K run, but will be asked to start with the walkers (for safety purposes).
