Applications Due October 3, 2012

The Redlands Branch AAUW is accepting applications from women who have previous college experience but whose schooling has been interrupted.

The applicant must be a resident of the area served by the Redlands Branch which includes Redlands, Yucaipa, Calimesa, Banning, Beaumont, Highland, Loma Linda, and San Bernardino.

The selected recipient should have clearly defined educational goals and should be currently enrolled in either a two-year or a four-year college/university.

Following selection, the scholarship will be given to the college or university the woman will be attending in the fall. Scholarships awarded will be in the amount of \$1,500 for students attending a four year university and in the amount of \$750 for students attending a community college or professional college. The intent is to assist the student with registration fees and/or books.

Preference is given, but not limited, to a bachelor's degree candidate or to a student near completion of an A.A. Program.

The recipient has from September 1 of the year selected until September 1 of the following year to use the scholarship.

LOCAL SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

1. Re-entry woman. The scholarship will be awarded to a woman with some previous college experience, whose schooling has been interrupted.
2. A woman who can show financial need.
3. A woman with educational goals clearly defined.
4. A woman who is a resident of the area served by the Redlands Branch AAUW.
5. The scholarship is \$1,500 for a four year college/university or \$750 for a community/professional college.
6. The intent is for the recipient to complete a minimum of an Associate degree with this financial assistance.
7. The woman must be currently enrolled in either a two year or four year college or university or a professional school.
8. Money goes to the college, university, or professional school (not the individual) the recipient attends in the fall following her selection.
9. Preference is given but not limited to a bachelor's degree candidate.
10. The number of recipients shall be determined on a year-to-year basis as per the outcome of fund-raising and review of the applications.
11. Recipients shall have from September 1 of the year they are selected until September 1 of the following year to use the scholarship.
