is currently accepting registration forms for summer day camp. Please join us this summer for any or all of the following:

- Drop-in day care/camp and emergency childcare for school-aged children, for our low hourly rate of \$5.00 an hour.
- This year we are offering multiple **discounted pre-payment options**. Families may prepay for Camp ASB for the entire summer, or for individual weeks that they know they will attend, and they will receive a significant discount on the hourly rate. This summer there will also be an option to prepay for all of the Camp ASB Field Trips. Prepaying for field trips reserves a spot for your child on each one of our summer field trips and reduces the cost of each field trip by nearly 20%.

Full summer: **\$1225.00** (per child) Per week: **\$175.00** (per child)

Camp ASB Field Trip Prepayment: **\$130.00** (per child)

- This year Camp ASB will continue to offer a number of field trips, see the summer calendar for more information.
- In addition to our Monday and Friday field trips we will also be including walking field trips that include View Ridge Park, Bryant Park and Bryant School Playground.

- A number of unique celebrations, including our annual “Six Months until Christmas party,” and the Camp ASB carnival (with bounce houses)

**Who:** Children entering grades **K - 7** (in the fall)

**When:** June 15<sup>th</sup>-July 31<sup>st</sup>. **Closed: July 3<sup>rd</sup> and August 1<sup>st</sup> - to August 28<sup>th</sup>** (this is a major change)

**Daily Hours:** **8:00 a.m. - 5:45 p.m.** Monday - Friday ("flex time" between 5:45 and 6:00).

After 6:00pm a **\$1.00 per minute** (per child) late fee will be charged. It is your responsibility to have someone pick-up your child(ren) by 6:00 p.m.

**Where:** Assumption-St. Bridget School FAFC building/gym, on NE 65<sup>th</sup> St., between 32<sup>nd</sup> and 33<sup>rd</sup> Ave NE.  
Activities will also take place at various locations in the immediate neighborhood of the school.

**Cost (ASB Family):** **\$55.00** registration fee *per family*, **\$5.00/hr per child**.

**Cost (non-ASB Family):** **\$55.00** registration fee *per family*, **\$7.00/hr per child**

**\*\*Prepayment options are available: \$175.00 per week or \$1225 for the entire summer** (please contact Dylan Pouley to arrange for prepayment).

**\*\* Prepayment field trip option also available: \$130.00 per child** will cover the cost of every field trip and secure a spot for your child on every field trip.

## Daily Itinerary

From the time we open at **8:00 a.m.** until closing time at 5:45 p.m., kids have opportunities to take part in arts and craft projects, group games, board games, computer activities, sports, reading, drawing, and many other pastimes. In addition to our normal daily activities we will also have specialty days each day during our Camp ASB week. The specialty days will be as follows:

- **Monday:** Some Monday field trips
- **Tuesday:** Trivia Tuesday (a Jeopardy-style trivia game) will be played in the morning following snack; afternoon field trip to Bryant Park
- **Wednesday:** Wii Wednesday (Nintendo Wii or Xbox Kinect games and activities periodically throughout the day) lunch time field trip to View Ridge Park
- **Thursday:** Morning field trip to Bryant Park, Theater Thursday (lunch-time movie)
- **Friday:** Some Friday field trips

## Field Trips

### Field Trip Information

Camp ASB is keeping the same format for our Monday and Friday field trips that we have used in past years. This summer every Monday and Friday on which a field trip is planned all of the children signed in to Camp ASB will attend the field trips. Walking field trips will not require Camp ASB to close, and families will be able to drop children off at Camp ASB during our walking field trips.

- If your child is attending Camp ASB on a day when a field trip is scheduled, you will be billed your normal hourly rates, and a \$20.00 field trip fee per child (per field trip attended) will be added to your bill for that month. **\*\*This year we are offering a field trip prepayment option of \$130.00 per child\*\***
- **Monday and Friday field trip hours will be 9:00am to 4:00pm.** Camp ASB will still have the same daily hours, but all children and staff will be off-site on the field trip between the hours of 9:00am and 4:00pm. **During field trip hours, on-site childcare is NOT available.**
- **at Camp ASB by 9:00 am on Mondays and Fridays when there are field trips.** If you need to pick your child up during the time that we are on the field trip, arrangements must be made in advance.
- Families may register for field trips in advance to secure a spot on the desired field trip. Some field trips have a limited number of spaces available. Families may also prepay for all of the field trips in advance and secure a spot on each of the field trips this summer. Please contact Dylan Pouley to register or prepay in advance.

## Camp ASB 2015 and Raising the Roof!

I would like to take an opportunity thank all of the families that use Camp ASB as their summer care provider. I would also like to thank the great number of families that have used Extended Care over the years, as before and or after school care for their family. We greatly appreciate your business and I want to assure everyone that I am doing my very best to make Extended Care and Camp ASB a safe, fun and affordable child-care option for our school families. As many of you may know, this year's fund-a-need item at the ASB School Auction was "Raise the Roof." ASB families generously pledged to contribute to the re-roofing of the Assumption Gym, FAFC building and the ASB 4<sup>th</sup> grade classrooms. Extended Care and Camp ASB is very thankful for the contributions of all ASB friends and families and we are looking forward to the improvements of our shared facilities.

In order to implement these improvements, it will become necessary for a great deal of construction and remodeling to take place in these facilities during this coming summer. The safety of our students and campers is always the highest priority in our programs and with this in mind, we have a major challenge in front of us this summer. After careful analysis and a cooperative effort between Seymour Silberstein (Facilities Director), Christina McGill and myself, it was decided that Camp ASB 2015 will be limited to seven weeks and will be closed for the entire month of August. We did not come to this decision lightly as we know that this may create a challenge for some of our ASB families. These improvements are not only going to improve the overall quality of the school and the programs that take place in the Gym and FAFC, they are mandatory to ensure the safety of our buildings and our students and staff.

Over the last seven years, Camp ASB has existed as a nine-week program. Camp ASB has always closed over the last two-three weeks of August to allow for mandatory facilities improvements and faculty meetings. This summer we will be reducing our program to a seven-week Camp ASB program that will take place over the months of June and July. This program will operate during the same daily hours as it has in the past and will include almost all of the activities and field trips that we have provided over the last seven years. I anticipate this seven-week program being more action packed and exciting than past years, as we will be attempting to pack all of our past activities into this shorter period of time.

I hope that all of you will understand and appreciate necessity of this change. I want to assure you that we are making this adjustment with the best needs of the entire ASB School community in mind.
