Rules for Microsoft Development Network Academic Alliance

Only Computer Science students, faculty, or staff may check out MSDN software. (a copy of a current fee statement is required for proof of enrollment/major)

Users must fill out the MSDN software checkout form. All spaces (except for office-use spaces) are required.

Borrowed software must be returned within three (3) working days to the Computer Science systems administrator staff in room 541 PGH (if staff is not present in room 541, return the software to the department assistant in room 501 PGH instead.) (Do not drop off MSDN software without identifying yourself, else you may be charged for its loss.)

Users must read and understand the attached **MSDNAA License Agreement**.

Users agree to use the borrowed software for installation only their personal computer(s), and only for their own personal, academic use.

Users agree not to make copies of, distribute, or loan the borrowed software.

The names of users borrowing MSDN software will be recorded by the Computer Science Department for purposes of record-keeping. **Please note that Microsoft is permitted to view such records** (of names, software borrowed, and times during which software was on loan) as they request.

Failure to abide by this agreement will cause a user's privileges to borrow MSDN software to be revoked.

Failure to return borrowed software will result in the Computer Science Department using its "best efforts to demand immediate return of or confirm destruction of" the borrowed software, according to the Computer Science Department's agreement with Microsoft.

Fines of \$100.00 per software set will be assessed for lost software.
