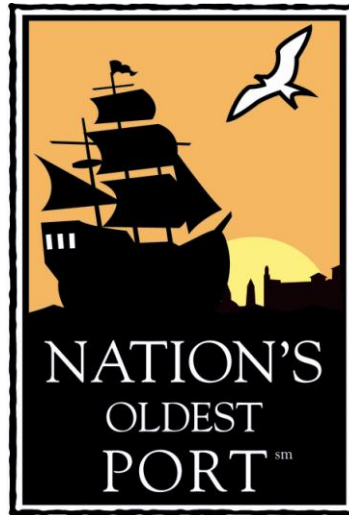
Explore the watery world of ships and why they wreck. From stars to charts, campers will learn what it takes to navigate waterways – but look out for the sandbar!
