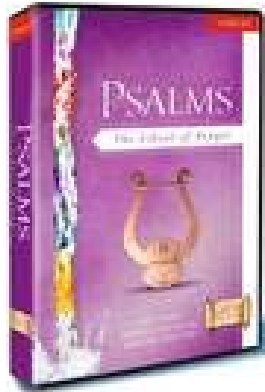

FORTNIGHT FOR FREEDOM

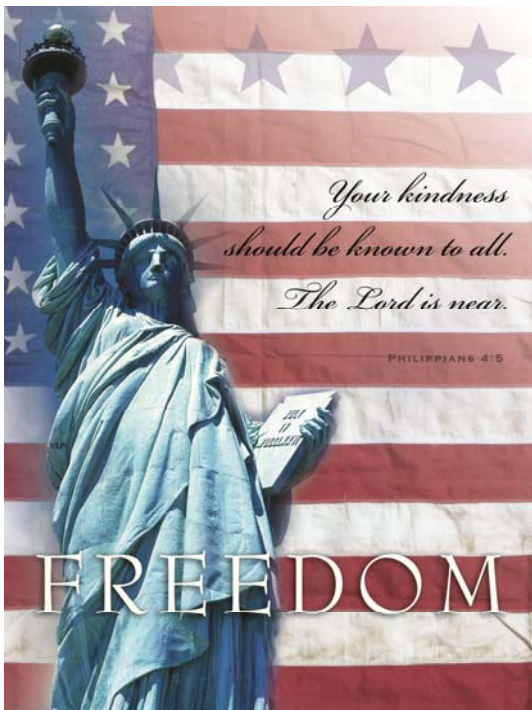

FIESTA DEL SANTISIMO CUERPO Y SANTISIMA SANGRE DE JESUS - CORPUS CHRISTI

Queridos Hermanos:

Aunque la Institución de la Sagrada Eucaristía es el Jueves Santo; La Iglesia ha querido consagrar otro día más a esta gran fiesta del Santísimo Cuerpo y Santísima Sangre del Señor, debido a la gran importancia que tiene este Sagrado Sacramento para nosotros. Como católicos sabemos y creemos, que Jesucristo está realmente presente en la Sagrada Eucaristía, bajo las especies del Pan y del Vino.

El Libro del Deuteronomio, nos recuerda que Dios alimentó con el maná bajado del Cielo, a su pueblo elegido en el desierto. Ese maná o pan bajado del Cielo, era prefiguración del verdadero Pan, quien es Jesucristo; El es el verdadero Pan bajado del Cielo. El pueblo de Israel, experimentó hambre y sed en el desierto, para luego experimentar la presencia de Dios, cuando a través de Moisés hizo brotar agua de la roca y llovió pan del cielo (maná); símbolo y prefiguración de la Sagrada Eucaristía. La travesía en el desierto, con dificultades y pruebas, es el símbolo de la peregrinación de cada uno de nosotros por este mundo. A lo largo de este peregrinar por esta tierra, tendremos la Sagrada Eucaristía, como alimento que fortalecerá nuestro espíritu. Podemos hablar de tres momentos en este gran Misterio de la Sagrada Eucaristía:

1. **PROMESA:** Jesús en el Evangelio, nos habla de su presencia real: "Yo Soy el Pan vivo bajado del cielo, quien coma de este Pan no morirá para siempre...Quien come mi Carne y bebe mi Sangre tiene Vida Eterna". Muchos judíos al escuchar estas palabras de Jesús, dijeron: "Es duro este lenguaje, quién podrá entenderlo". Y desde ese momento muchos judíos no creyeron más en Jesús y se fueron. Solamente se quedó Jesús con los doce Apóstoles. Y Jesús les dice a ellos: "Ustedes también quieren irse, ustedes también me quieren dejar solo"...Allí había un gran silencio, entonces Pedro tomó la palabra diciendo: "Señor a quién iremos...todos sabemos que Tú tienes palabras de Vida Eterna...y sabemos que Tú eres el Mesías el Hijo de Dios vivo".

2. **REALIZACION:** La noche del Jueves Santo, Jesús tomó el pan y se lo dió a sus Apóstoles diciendo: "Tomen y coman, esto es mi Cuerpo...Esta es mi Carne...y luego tomó una copa llena de vino y se la dió a sus Apóstoles diciendo: "Tomen y beban, esta es mi Sangre que será derramada por ustedes"...Y luego les dijo: "Hagan esto en memoria mía".

3. **ACTUALIZACION:** El Apóstol San Pablo nos dice: "Yo recibí esta tradición del Señor, que a mi vez les he transmitido: que el Señor Jesús, la noche que fue entregado...tomó pan y lo partió diciendo: Tomen y coman esto es mi Cuerpo que será entregado por ustedes...De la misma manera tomó la copa llena de vino, diciendo: Esta copa es mi Sangre de la Nueva Alianza que será derramada por ustedes...Hagan esto en memoria mía...Por lo tanto, cada vez que comemos el Cuerpo de Cristo y bebemos su Sangre, estamos anunciando su muerte y proclamamos su resurrección hasta que El regrese...Y recuerden: Si alguien come el Cuerpo de Cristo y bebe su Sangre indignamente (es decir en pecado mortal), se está comiendo y se está bebiendo su propia condenación. Por eso que cada uno examine su conciencia, antes de recibir al Señor".

Pidámosle a la Virgen María, para que Ella, nos ayude a creer y vivir profundamente, este maravilloso Sacramento que nos ha dejado Jesucristo, como es la Sagrada Eucaristía.
