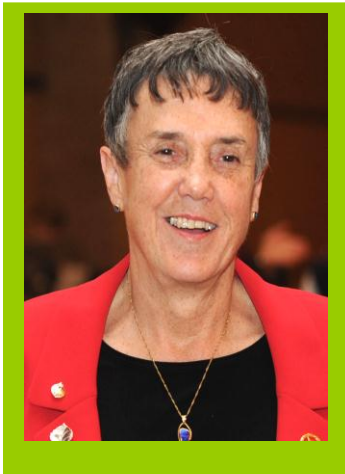

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This program will explore perianesthesia nursing practice and legal implications for nurses caring for perioperative patients in Preop, PACU, Phase 1 and Phase 2; such as PACU emergencies, pain management; defensive documentation (EMR), ASPAN Standards, consents, critical assessments and decision making; chain of command; periop patient assessment, discharge dilemmas, and depositions.

OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this educational program, the participant will be able to:

- Describe acceptable protocols and standing orders for the perianesthesia arena.
- Apply ASPAN standards when addressing legal situations in Phase I and Phase 2 regarding staffing, patient assessment, care planning, and documentation.
- Identify post operative emergencies and responses to achieve positive patient outcomes.
- Identify regulatory requirements of EMR documentation.
- Describe perianesthesia nursing documentation requirements.
- Identify four elements of medical malpractice to consider when giving a deposition.
- State three basic concepts to understand before a deposition or testifying in court.
- Define Horizontal Violence and harassment in the work place.
- Describe strategies for managing horizontal violence.
