**AN EVALUATION SHEET: WHAT TO LOOK FOR IN A SERMON**

<b>Purpose</b>	What is the primary purpose of the sermon?
	In what ways does the preacher express the Bible message?
<b>Setting</b>	In what ways is the preaching fitting for the moment?
<b>Awareness</b>	In what ways does the preacher show sensitivity to the listeners?
<b>Biblical Foundation</b>	Is the sermon faithful to the "faith of scripture"? (with respect to expansion, biblical faith and contemporary relevance)
<b>Faith of the Preacher</b>	What is the faith of the preacher, expressed or implied?
<b>Content</b>	In what way is the substance of the sermon clear, fresh, and relevant to its purpose (with respect to general statements and concrete particulars)?
<b>Communication Style</b>	How does the preacher communicate with the hearers?
<b>Delivery</b>	Is the message delivered as direct personal speech of commanding importance?
