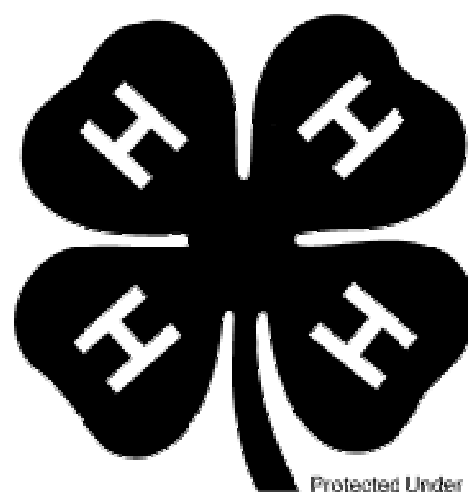

## 2014 4-H Summer Day Camp Information & Registration

Read through this camp brochure as soon as it is received... the **camps have limited enrollment and they fill up fast!**

**Youth not currently enrolled in 4-H (or who have enrolled after March 1, 2014) are welcomed to register on or after May 19th 2014.**

**4-H Age is determined by how old campers were on September 1st, 2013, NOT their age at the time of the camp.**

Eligible 4-H members are advised to mail or hand-deliver the registration form and payment to the 4-H Office by **FRIDAY, MAY 16th**. **Phone registrations are not accepted.** Campers are not registered until registration form and payment have been received by the 4-H Office.

Full refunds will be given if notice of cancellation is provided at least TWO weeks prior to the first day of the camp (Refunds do NOT include Clover Award monies).

**Unless noted, all camps are held at the St. Johns County Extension Office or Wind Mitigation Building. Some camps include fieldtrips.**

Youth registering for camps agree to allow photos taken to be used for promotional purposes.

### Attire should be 4-H appropriate

- NO spaghetti straps or tank tops
- Shorts should be fingertip length or longer
- 4-H t-shirts or polo shirts preferred
- Close toed shoes required
