1. Applicants must have declared a sequence in the Journalism Department as their major, and be enrolled full-time in the School of Communications for two consecutive semesters. Freshman and sophomores must have an overall GPA of 3.0. However, juniors and seniors must have a 3.0 GPA in their major as well as an overall 3.0 GPA.
2. In addition to the completed application, please attach the following:
 - a. *current resume*
 - b. *a letter of recommendation*
 - c. *Howard University documentation that outlines sources of your financial aid* (may be obtained from financial aid department or can be downloaded from Bison Web).
 - d. *financial worksheet*
 - e. *unofficial transcript* (transcript may be obtained from the Educational Advisory Service office, room C-107 or can be downloaded from Bison Web)
 - f. *student scholarship submission checklist*
3. Scholarship application packets should be submitted in hard copy form, in one envelope. Please write "Fall 2012 Scholarship" on the outside of the envelope, and be sure to attach the checklist to the outside of the envelope.
4. Scholarship application packets should be submitted between the hours of 9 a.m. – 2 p.m. to Ms. Alexandria Murph in the Journalism Department office (room C-246).
5. Applications are due by April 30, 2012, at 2 p.m.
6. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
