

It is my goal to assist students in making educational, occupational, and life plans that help them develop into productive, successful citizens. Some of my responsibilities include working with students to aid in course selection, choosing appropriate post-secondary plans, aiding with goal setting and achieving, finding resources, and keeping the lines of communication open. Please be aware that I put a lot of valuable information on the Guidance Webpage and Guidance Bulletin Board (Board next to exit to the mobiles) quite regularly, so be sure to check these often. If you have any questions, comments or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact me at any time! ⁽²⁾ Have a great year, Giants!!

Academic Information

Students, be sure to start the year off on the right foot:

- Use your assignment notebooks to stay organized and keep track of homework assignments
- Check your grades regularly! Please call the Main Office if you have forgotten your PowerSchool username or password
- Utilize your 5th hour study hall to complete homework, ask your teacher questions, and study ahead of time for tests

Post-Secondary Information

Please pay attention to and check the Guidance Bulletin Board and website regularly for:

- COLLEGE REPRESENTATIVES admissions counselors from schools all over the country schedule times to
 come to AHHS and are available to sit down with you during your lunch period. This is a chance to learn about schools and ask
 questions before you visit or apply. These are very informational and can be very helpful in deciding which school is a good fit
 for you.
- TESTING all upcoming tests will be advertised on the calendar to notify you of which tests are coming up, and the deadlines to register.
- APPLICATION DUE DATES & IMPORTANT EVENTS
- COLLEGE FAIRS I will list where and when various college fairs will be held so you can obtain multiple colleges' information in one location.

Seniors... many colleges have priority deadlines coming up in November. It might seem far off, but it will come up fast! Applying for college early often provides you with benefits, such as increased scholarships, financial aid opportunities, priority housing or course selection, and if you are on the 'bubble' with admission requirements. GET THOSE APPLICATIONS IN!! If you need help finding a college, applications, or information, stop by the Guidance Office. Please be aware that in September, **all seniors will be having individual meetings**

with Mrs. Schuda to discuss post-secondary plans. Please adhere to your pass time when you receive it and check the guidance bulletin board for when your counselor meeting is scheduled.

Seniors – please turn in your Letter of Recommendation Forms to Mrs. Schuda ASAP. The counselor will hold those forms and can make copies of them at any time for you to ask a teacher or coach for a letter when filling out college applications. Your request for a letter with automatically be denied without this completed form!

Testing

Sophomores and juniors, it is time to sign up for the <u>PSAT</u>. The Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT) is a standardized test that provides students with firsthand practice for the SAT[®]. It also gives you a chance to enter NMSC scholarship programs and gain access to college and career planning tools. You can sign up in the main office. The fee is \$14 & you will be given a study guide booklet once you bring in your check and the test will be held on Wednesday, October 15th.

Juniors and seniors: <u>register for another ACT</u>. Test dates and registration deadlines can be found on the Guidance Webpage and the Guidance Bulletin Board. Please visit www.act.or to register. The next test is scheduled on October 25, 2014, and the registration deadline is September 19th!

Homework Solutions

Like an actor rehearsing his lines or a batter working on his swing, your child does homework for practice what he learns in school. And if he's like most youngsters, homework brings occasional challenges. Here are solutions to common problems he may face.

Getting Started

When your child gets home from school, he might want to relax for a little while, or he may want to jump right in and work. Have him try each method for one week and keep track of how it goes. He could write notes in each day's calendar square. ("Went great!" or "Hard time getting started.") After two weeks, he can review his notes to see which routine works best for him.

Staying Motivated

Does your student feel restless while doing homework? Suggest that he get up and move to a new spot. For example, he may finish his vocabulary assignment at the kitchen table and then read his science chapter on the porch. A planned break (ex. snack or walk) can also give him a second wind!

Solving Problems

Help your child make a list of strategies he can use when he gets stuck. For a math assignment, he might try tools like a number line or find sample problems in his book. When he's reading, he could look up words in a dictionary or reread a paragraph. – Home & School Connection, 2014
