WHO DO YOU HELP?

For two years, Maddy had a knot on her left hand, which her family thought was a cyst. It never bothered her and it did not hurt. Kids in Maddy's class would often ask her what it was, so her parents decided it was time to have it removed. Two weeks before Maddy's eighth birthday, tests revealed that the knot was actually a rare soft tissue tumor called an epithelioid sarcoma. Her family was devastated. Maddy's doctor referred her to St. Jude Children's Research Hospital immediately for her treatment and care.

At St. Jude, Maddy's treatment included surgery to remove the tumor, radiation and skin grafts. She is now finished with treatment and returns to St. Jude every three months for checkups. Maddy and her family love St. Jude. "It is the most amazing place in the world for patients and families," said her mom, Kerri. Maddy is an intelligent and fun-loving girl who likes to hang out with her friends.
