DINO BABERS

Eastern Illinois
Head Football Coach
(Hawai'i, 1984)
1st Season



A new era of Eastern Illinois football begins as Dino Babers was hired as the 22nd head coach in Eastern Illinois University football history. He was announced as the new head coach by EIU University President Dr. William Perry and athletic director Barbara Burke before a large crowd in the EIU University Ball Room on Dec. 9, 2011.

Babers most recently served the special teams coordinator and wide receivers coach at Baylor University where the Bears featured one of the most explosive offenses in the nation.

With a smile on his face, Babers accepted the job by simply saying he was humbled to have been considered and selected to be the head coach at Eastern Illinois following in the footsteps of a man who first hired him on the EIU staff back in 1987, Bob Spoo.

"I am humbled to be your new head football coach. I love where I am at and I can't wait to get where we are going," Babers said. "I can't wait to see the smiles on the faces of the players, the community and this great academic institution on the things we are going to do on and off the field. We are going to set this community on fire."

One of the things that attracted Babers to the administration at Eastern Illinois was the type of man he is and the type of offense he planned on running.

"We are excited about a new era of Panther football," Burke said. "We were fortunate to have a great pool of candidates to select from. It was not an easy decision. I am glad it wasn't easy, it shows that people care about this program and EIU. When I spoke to people around the nation, two things kept coming up about Dino Babers. 1.) He is a man of outstanding character. 2.) He has a great offensive football mind. Lastly one person I respect called me and said I would be crazy not to hire Dino."

With Babers on the staff Baylor's explosive offense ranked second in the nation in 2011 in total offense as he helped coach 2011 Heisman Trophy winner Robert Griffin III. In 2010, Baylor's offensive unit ranked 12th in the nation in total offense. As the wide receivers coach, Babers coached All-Big 12 receiver David Gettis, a 2010 draft pick of the Carolina Panthers.

Babers coached four seasons at Baylor helping head coach Art Briles rebuild the program. Baylor made its second straight bowl game appearance with a win over Washington in the Alamo Bowl in 2011. In 2010 Baylor played Illinois in the Texas Bowl.

"He will be a great leader of your football program," Briles said. "He is an outstanding man, a great father and husband."

Babers joined the Baylor program after four seasons as the assistant head coach at UCLA on the staff of Karl Dorrell. At UCLA Babers helped coach the Bruins to four straight bowl appearances.

"He is a tremendous coach that brings a wealth of experience," said Dorrell. "He has coached every position on offense. As a recruiter he is energetic and can make that connection to players."

Babers mentioned that he would have a national base for recruiting with the primary emphasis on winning Illinois and the bordering states. He thanked the EIU administration for its support of that vision and the financial backing to have that national recruiting philosophy.

"The formula for success is going to follow the game plan we started at Baylor. We have to start with the product, and the product is the players," Babers added. "We want to attack them not only on the field from a strength and development standpoint, but also socially, morally and spiritually. All of those things are involved to making sure we get the best person we can on the football field."

Babers continued by saying "After that we are going to get into the community and get them behind us. We are going to play an exciting brand of football. It is something people are going to want to come out and see and it's going to be the thing to do on Saturdays. If you're not watching us, then you're not in the place where all the action is."

Prior to his time at UCLA, Babers spent one season at Pittsburgh following offensive coordinator stints at Texas A&M and Arizona. In 1998 he helped Arizona post a 12-1 record with a number four national ranking. In 1999 his offensive unit ranked third in the nation in total offense at 471.9 yards per game.

Babers entered the coaching profession as a graduate assistant at Hawai'i for one season and for two years as a graduate assistant at Arizona State. ASU earned a trip the Rose Bowl following the 1986 season. He was hired as a part of Bob Spoo's first staff at Eastern Illinois in 1987. Babers mentioned that EIU was a place that he always thought might be a head coaching destination.

"All during my career I have always circled Eastern Illinois on my resume and said to myself – If that job ever came open I would love to be considered to be the next head coach of that program." Babers then joked by saying "it only took 25 years for Coach Spoo to retire for that opening to occur. That is a tribute to the type of program he has built here and the success they have been able to have."

Babers has had success at every stop of his coaching career. He has coached 23 former players who eventually played in the National Football League during his more than 25 years in the college coaching profession.

A native of San Diego, Calif., Babers was a four-year starter at Hawai'i earned All-Western Athletic Conference Academic honors. He was a free agent signee with the British Columbia Lions of the Canadian Football League when an injury in camp ended his professional career. He earned his undergraduate degree from Hawai'i in 1984 and a masters degree from Arizona State in 1988. He and his wife Susan have four daughters – Breeahnah, Tasha, Jazzmin and Paris.

KIM MCCLOUD
Defensive Coordinator
(Hawai'i, 1991) - 1st Season

Kim McCloud enters his first season as the defensive coordinator on head coach Dino Babers Eastern Illinois staff. McCloud and Babers previously worked together on the staff at Baylor University where McCloud coached the secondary from 2008-2010. McCloud comes to EIU following one season as the defensive backs coach at Akron.

McCloud has been in the collegiate coaching profession for more than a decade with post-season appearances at Baylor, Idaho, Missouri and Nevada.

At Baylor he helped coach an All-Big 12 safety in 2009 and 2010 while helping the Bears make an appearance in the Texas Bowl in 2010. Byron Lander was All-Big 12 in 2010 while Jordan Lake was All-Big 12 in 2008 and 2009. Lander totaled a team-high 127 tackles as a senior. Lake had back-to-back seasons with 90-plus tackles under McCloud's direction. In 2009 McCloud also coached Chance Casey, an All-Big 12 Freshman selection. During his final two seasons at Baylor, McCloud served as the Bear's defensive recruiting coordinator.

Prior to his time at Baylor, McCloud was an assistant at Nevada for eight seasons where he coached the defensive secondary in seven of his eight years. He moved over to coach the wide receivers during the 2004 season. During his final three seasons on the Wolf Pack staff, Nevada made three straight bowl appearances and won the 2006 Western Athletic Conference title.

McCloud coached a pair All-WAC performers at Nevada with one first team selection on each side of the ball. Joe Garcia was a two-time All-WAC selection ranking 14th in the nation in interceptions in 2006. During his one season on the offensive side of the ball, wide receiver Nichiren Flowers was second in the WAC with 91 receptions.

A native of Los Angeles, Calif., McCloud was a four-year letterman and three-year starter at Hawai'i earning honorable mention All-WAC honors as a defensive back. He was a 1990 All-WAC Academic team selection earning his degree in 1991.

He signed a free agent contract with the San Diego Chargers in 1991 and played two seasons in the Canadian Football League (1991 & 1992) with the Saskatchewan Roughriders.

Following his playing career McCloud broke into the coaching ranks at Kaiser High School in Honolulu. He was a graduate assistant at Missouri in 1997 and helped the Tigers earn a Holiday Bowl Invitation. In 1998 he joined the staff at Idaho as a corner backs coach where the Vandals won the Big West Conference and capped the season with a win in the Humanitarian Bowl.

McCloud and his wife Renee have two children, Kaleb and Rachel.

STERLIN GILBERT
Offensive Coordinator
Quarterbacks Coach
(Angelo State, 2002) - 1st Season

Sterlin Gilbert begins his first season as an assistant coach on head coach Dino Baber's Eastern Illinois staff. Gilbert will serve as the Panthers quarterback coach and offensive coordinator.

Gilbert comes to EIU following a successful career as a prep coach in Texas. Most recently he served as the offensive coordinator & quarterback coach at Temple High School where the team advanced to the Texas Class 5-AAAAA playoffs.

Prior to joining the staff at Temple HS, Gilbert served as the head coach at San Angelo Lake View High School for three seasons (2008-10). Gilbert rebuilt a program that had won only three games in three years prior to his arrival to a team that won the 2008 Bi-District Championship and the school's first playoff win in 12 years. He was named the West Texas High School Coach of the Year in 2008.

Gilbert developed a name for himself as a prolific offensive coach at Cooper High School in Abilene during the 2006 and 2007 seasons when he served as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach. His 2006 offense led 5A with 3,172 yards passing. In 2007 the team advanced to the Texas Class 3-AAAAA playoffs.

Gilbert's first collegiate coaching experience was as a graduate assistant at Houston in 2005 when the Cougars earned a trip to the Fort Worth Bowl. Gilbert assisted the quarterbacks coach with the quarterbacks and running backs.

His first job was as the quarterbacks and running backs coach at Springtown High School from 2003-05.

A Texas native, Gilbert was a two-time All-Lone Star Conference quarterback at Angelo State in 2000 and 2001. He earned his degree in 2002 after serving as a two-time team captain. Angelo State won the Lone Star Conference South Division in 1999 and 2000. Gilbert was a two-time All-State quarterback at San Angelo Lake View HS.

2012 EASTERN ILLINOIS FOOTBALL SPRING NOTES



OUTLOOK

A new era of Eastern Illinois football is underway as Dino Babers was hired as the 22nd head coach in the history of Eastern Illinois football and the fourth in the NCAA Division I era. A long time assistant coach at several FBS programs, Babers most recently worked as the wide receivers/special teams coach at Baylor University where the Bears incorporated a high octane offense under the direction of Heisman Trophy winner Robert Griffin III. While EIU may not have the next Heisman Trophy winner on its roster that will not preclude the Panthers from implementing their own version of the fast break offense. During his opening press conference Babers mentioned that he would like to build a new level of excitement around EIU Panther Football.

Following two straight 2-9 seasons the Panthers look ready to improve upon those numbers. EIU has some of the pieces in place to run its up-tempo offense and if that unit can become cohesive the Panthers should be able to put points on the board. A large part the defense returns from last season with seven starters back from a young team. Should the Panthers be able to put things together on both sides of the ball look for a competitive team that can challenge for an upper half finish in the OVC.

OFFENSE OUTLOOK

Eastern Illinois will change its look on offense as the Panthers will incorporate an up-tempo style similar to what Baylor University has run the past couple of seasons. Head coach Dino Babers along with offensive coordinator Sterlin Gilbert and outside receivers coach Andrew Sowder have coached in the system and will modify it to fit Eastern Illinois. The Panthers return quarterback Jimmy Garappolo who passed for more than 2,600 yards and 20 touchdowns last season. Top target Chris Wright returns after catching 42 passes for 735 yards and 11 touchdowns. EIU also regains the services of receiver Erik Lora who led the team in receiving in 2010 and missed last season due to injury. The Panthers have three running backs returning from last year with Jake Walker the leader with 580 yards and 10 touchdowns. The offensive line returns four starters from last year as the unit will be playing together for the third straight season.

SPECIAL TEAMS OUTLOOK

EIU returns most of its special teams unit from last season. Junior Cameron Berra has established himself as a steady place kicker making 7-of-9 field goals last season after knocking home 8-of-11 as a freshman. Scott Weatherford took over the punter duties last season and did a capable job averaging 37.6 yards per kick with 12 downed inside the 20 yard line. EIU will need to replace its kick off and punt return specialists.

DEFENSIVE OUTLOOK

The Panthers return seven of eleven players that started the final game of the season. All four players on the Panthers front defensive line return along with three back-ups at that position. EIU can build around All-OVC selection Artavious Dowdell who has led the team in tackles for loss and sacks that past two seasons. Dowdell led the conference in sacks in 2010 and was third in the league in 2011. The Panthers are solid in the middle with starters Roosevelt Holiday and Jon Voytilla combining for seven tackles for loss. A majority of the defensive secondary returns led by corner backs DJ Bland and Pete Houlihan. Bland was a special teams stand out with two blocked kicks and had three pass break-ups. Safety Nick Beard led the Panthers with six pass break-ups and was fourth on the team in tackles. The lone starting linebacker from last season is Antonio Taylor who will take on more of a leadership role with this year's unit. He was second on the team in tackles last season with 92.

RECRUITING CLASS

Eastern Illinois signed only 11 players to head coach Dino Babers first recruiting class. Those players fit several needs as the Panthers added to the offensive line, defensive back field and running back position. The EIU coaching staff held a couple of scholarship spots that may be filled this summer with incoming freshman or four-year transfers.

THE SCHEDULE

Eastern Illinois will face a tough FCS schedule this year with three teams from last year's NCAA FCS playoffs on the slate along with two other teams that were on the cusp of making the field. EIU opens the season on Thursday, August 30 against in-state rival Southern Illinois. The Panthers will then travel to FBS opponent Western Michigan before playing the 101st Mid-America Classic contest at Illinois State. The Ohio Valley Conference season opens at home with Murray State on Sept. 22. EIU will also host Austin Peay, Jacksonville State and Southeast Missouri for league games. The Panthers play OVC contests at UT Martin, Eastern Kentucky and Tennessee Tech. The regular season ends at Central Arkansas on Nov. 17. EIU does not play OVC member Tennessee State this season.

#13 - VON WISE

Tight End

RS-Senior (6-4, 209)

Cincinnati, Ohio/Finneytown HS

Wise was a second team All-Ohio Valley Conference selection at tight end in 2011. He was third on the Panthers team with 32 receptions for 348 yards per game. He led all OVC tight ends in receptions. Wise averaged 10.9 yards per reception with a long of 23 yards. He had two touchdown receptions. Wise is a big tight end that allows the Panthers to stretch the field when he lines up at either the natural tight end position or in the inside slot.



#32 - ARTAVIOUS DOWDELL

Defensive End

Senior (6-2, 230)

Belle Glade, Fla./Glades Central

Dowdell was a second team All-Ohio Valley Conference selection at defensive end in 2011. Dowdell led the Panthers in tackles for loss and sacks for the second straight season. He recorded 7.5 tackles for loss and 5.0 sacks. Dowdell was third in the OVC in sacks per game in 2011 after leading the OVC in sacks per game as a sophomore. A dynamic pass rusher he finished with 45 tackles (23 solo) adding seven quarterback hurries and two pass break-ups to his season statistics. Dowdell is poised break into the Panthers career top ten for sacks and tackles for loss during his senior season. He has 12.5 career sacks and 24 career tackles for loss.



#81 - CHRIS WRIGHT

Wide Receiver

Senior (6-1, 177)

Skokie, Ill./Niles West HS

Wright enters the fall as one of the top returning play makers in the Ohio Valley Conference. A big play receiver, Wright led the OVC in touchdown receptions with 11 last season as he broke into the EIU career touchdown receptions top ten list with 21. He hauled in 42 passes for a team-high 735 yards. Wright ranked 45th in the NCAA in receiving yards per game. He has 84 career receptions in three seasons with 1,555 career receiving yards.
