

# Scholarship Application

The Golden Empire Council, Boy Scouts of America offers three scholarships: the American Ideals Scholarship, the Michael W. Wolfe Scholarship, and the Fum Jongeneel Scholarship. The amount of each scholarship, and their criteria for eligibility are listed below. Please read the criteria for each scholarship <u>carefully</u> and apply for it only if you meet <u>all</u> requirements. There is a single application form for all three scholarships. Applicants will be considered for any scholarships for which they qualify. All applicants must be currently registered members of the Golden Empire Council.

The application form must be returned <u>postmarked</u> no later than February 28th. Additional application forms can be obtained from any Golden Empire Council Office or downloaded from the Council Website: www.gec-bsa.org.

When filling out the application form it is extremely important that you complete the entire application thoroughly and accurately. Applications should be typed, if at all possible, or clearly <u>printed</u> and signed. The 350 word statement <u>must</u> also be typed and signed. Submit <u>only</u> the materials required in a <u>single envelope</u> and mail to the Golden Empire Council, P.O. Box 13558, Sacramento, CA 95853-3558. Non-required materials or materials submitted separately will <u>not</u> be considered.

## AMERICAN IDEALS SCHOLARSHIP

Amount: Up to \$1,000.00 February 28th

Criteria:

- 1. Must have completed all requirements and been approved by a District Board of Review for the rank of Eagle Scout by the February 1<sup>st</sup> prior to scholarship deadline.
- 2. Must be a registered member of the Golden Empire Council, Boy Scouts of America;
- 3. Must be a high school senior who will graduate from high school by spring of the scholarship deadline year.
- 4. Must plan to attend an accredited two-year or four year college or university.
- 5. Must have a minimum overall grade point average (GPA) of 3.01 with an official transcript with a record of all academic work completed through fall, prior to deadline.
- 6. Must submit a letter of recommendation from (1) his Scout Leader and (2) a member of his high school staff (teacher, advisor, counselor, or principal) who knows about the Scout's scholarship and activities in high school;
- 7. Must include a statement of no more than 350 words describing an obstacle or challenge the Scout encountered in completing his Eagle project or some other area of his life, and how he resolved it. He may include special concerns/considerations he thinks the selection committee should be aware of.

# FUM JONGENEEL SCHOLARSHIP

Amount: \$1,000.00 **Due Date:** February 28th

Criteria:

- 1. Need **not** be an Eagle Scout to apply;
- 2. Be a registered member active in Sea Scouts, Venturing, or Explorers of the Golden Empire Council;
- 3. Have participated in a majority of his or her unit's activities in the past 12 months;
- 4. Be a high school senior who will graduate from high school by spring of scholarship deadline year.
- Submit an official transcript of all academic work in high school:
- 6. Plan to attend a two-year or four year college or university or an accredited trade/vocational school;
- 7. Submit a letter of recommendation from his or her unit leader and from his or her high school advisor, counselor, or principal; the letter from the unit leader should address and confirm each of the items required in the applicant's letter.
- 8. Provide a 350-word statement describing an obstacle or challenge the applicant encountered in completing a project in a particular area of his or her life, and how he or she resolved it.

## MICHAEL W. WOLFE SCHOLARSHIP

Amount: Up to \$10,000, depending on the direct costs of attending college (tuition, books, room and board, and fees) and the amount available from an endowment fund. The successful recipient may apply for the Wolfe Scholarship for his second year in college, but will compete with high school seniors who are applying in that year.

**<u>Due Date</u>**: February 28th

#### Criteria:

- 1. Must have completed all requirements and been approved by a District Board of Review for the rank of Eagle Scout by February 1<sup>st</sup> prior to scholarship deadline;
- 2. Must be a registered member of the Golden Empire Council, Boy Scouts of America;
- 3. Must be a high school senior who will graduate from high school by spring, of deadline year;
- 4. Must plan to at attend an accredited four year college or university;
- 5. Must have a minimum overall grade point average (GPA) of 3.01 with an official transcript with a record of all academic work completed through fall prior to deadline;
- 6. Must submit official SAT or ACT scores with transcript;
- 7. Must submit a letter of recommendation from (1) his Scout Leader and (2) a member of his high school staff (teacher, counselor, advisor or principal) who knows the Scout's scholarship and activities in high school;
- 8. Must include a statement of no more than 350 words describing an obstacle or challenge the Scout encountered in completing his Eagle project or some other area of his life, and how he resolved it. He may include special concerns/considerations he thinks the selection committee should be aware of;
- 9. Must demonstrate a commitment to Scouting during his collegiate years.

#### **Applicant Statement Instructions:**

Applicant's statement must be no more than 350 words long describing an obstacle or challenge the applicant encountered either in completing his Eagle project, or elsewhere in life, and how he or she resolved it. The applicant may add any special concerns/considerations of which he or she thinks the committee should be aware. The statement must be typed, double-spaced, with 1-inch margins and a 12-point font, and signed.

If necessary, additional sheets may be used to provide the information requested on this form. Information not specifically requested will not be considered.

#### **Check List:**

Be sure you include all the following items in your application envelope:

- Completed application form
- Essay
- Two reference letters (from school and Scout leader)
- Official school transcript (with SAT/ACT scores)
