Important Notes

Remember that this event is outside, RAIN OR SHINE, so plan accordingly. You must plan to stay for the entire event, from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

SETTING UP:

- Your products, what you plan to showcase or sell
- Tables, shelves, boxes. You must pre-register for tables, chairs and electricity.
- Don't forget a 10'x10' tent to cover your booth and weights to secure your tent down.
- Tents not weighted properly will be required to be removed at the HRCA's discretion. No exceptions.
- A Necessity Box with tape, scissors, string, a glue gun, etc.
- Signs/Banners (Names of crafts/business, prices, etc.)
- A Cash Box with change \$1's and \$5's
- Fabric or a drop cloth to cover and decorate your table
- A dolly or moving cart to move your items
- Family member or friends to help unload and set up!
- A water bottle, snacks, and a sweater or coat

** Enter Town Center via Lucent Blvd., as Highlands Ranch Parkway will be closed between Broadway and Lucent. Exit C-470 at Lucent, cross Highlands Ranch Parkway and make a Left on Mayberry. Continue straight into the Town Center.

THOUGHTS ABOUT YOUR BOOTH

- Consider various booth setups, using wood, fabric, floral, etc.

Vendor Booths

REGULAR SPACE

This 10'x10' space will be ample for most vendors. It is MANDATORY that you bring your own 10x10 tent/canopy and 50lb weights for each corner, to safely secure the tent. Due to the long hours of this event a tent is required for each vendor to protect against various weather conditions. The booth spaces will be on asphalt in the streets of Town Center Square. The HRCA will require any tent or canopy not safely secured down to be removed.

Details

TABLES & CHAIRS

We have a limited number of 6' x 2.5' tables and chairs available for rent. You must register in advance for these, rental fee will double the day of the event, and there is no guarantee they will be available.

TFNTS

This is a significant safety issue as the Town Center often experiences gusty winds. It is required that your tent be secured with weights to prevent it from blowing over. Please do not simply rest weights on the feet of tent legs. HRCA will be checking to ensure that weights are being used. Any tent not properly weighted and secured will be asked to be taken down. You will be held responsible for any damage your tent may cause. HRCA will not be held responsible for damage caused by your tent.

ELECTRICITY

This event is OUTSIDE, and because many vendors require electrical power, we offer electricity for an added fee. The outlets and amps available for use are limited! If you choose to purchase electricity, it is critical we know what you will be powering to supply enough electricity to your booth.

TAXES


If you have your own Sales Tax ID, you may file taxes on your own, or you may choose to have the HRCA take care of your taxes. If you do not have a Sales Tax ID, you must collect 5.1% sales tax on each item you sell, and turn the money into HRCA. If you choose to have HRCA handle your taxes, please turn in your envelope to the HRCA Administrative Office by Friday, July 8, 2011 at the Recreation Center at Eastridge. Checks can be made payable to Department of Revenue. You may also find a Sales Tax Calculator at businesstax.state.co.us. Click on Sales Tax Rate Charts, enter the tax rate and hit the Calculator button. Taxes are broken down as follows: State Sales Tax 2.9%, County 1.0%, RTD 1.0%, SCFD 0.1% and FSD 0.1%.
