## PARKING PRIVILEGES

You MAY park in:

- Designated "disabled" parking spaces.
- Metered zones without payment.
- Green zones without restrictions to time limits.
- Streets where preferential parking privileges are given to residents and merchants.

You MAY NOT park in:

- Red zones.
- Tow away zones.
- White or Yellow (loading) zones.
- Crosshatch marked spaces next to designated "disabled" parking spaces.

NOTE: Private parking facilities may have their own rules. Please follow rules posted at private facilities.

## ILLEGAL PARKING

Violations are a misdemeanor and are subject to fines up to $\$ 3,500$ and/or imprisonment up to 6 months in the county jail per California Vehicle Code §4461(d).

## FUEL PURCHASE

(Business \& Professions Code §13660)
State law requires service stations to refuel a disabled person's vehicle at self-service pumps, at self-service rates, except self-service facilities with only one employee.
