<u>The President Speaks</u> By Jerry Gilley

The two scholarship annual fund raisers are the Sporting Clays Tournament and Membership Drive in August, and the Golf Tournament and Membership Drive on October 5. Registration is underway for the August 13 and 14 Sporting Clays at the Dallas Gun Club. At last report, 67 teams have registered. Early registration for repeating teams ends July 14. New teams may register July 15 - 28. The tournament will be limited to 100 teams. Registration information is in this newsletter. Form a team and help us meet our scholarship goal while enjoying the activity.

You must be a DFW AADE member to participate in these tournaments. Why not get your membership handled prior to the event? Fill out the application, bring it to the July meeting, or mail in with your \$20.00 payment.

Thanks to all who attended the June meeting. There were 72 in attendance and we had a great meeting. Alan Farquharson, Senior VP – Reservoir Engr, with Range Resources, discussed the Marcellus/Devonian shale play in Pennsylvania. Range drilled their first well in 2004 and the first horizontal in 2006. They set four casing strings by 1800' (conductor, fresh water, coal seam, and surface) and then drill to TD. They plan to increase rig activity from the current 2 rigs to 6 rigs by year end. Daily production at end 2008 was 30 MMCFPD. They target 80 to 100 MMCFPD by end 2009. Their best vertical completion is 7 MMCFPD and the best horizontal is 24 MMCFPD. Drilling permit time is approx 45 days, which includes the water usage permit. A Marcellus Shale Committee is working with regulatory agencies to improve regulations for the play.

The July meeting will be at the Fort Worth Petroleum Club. Kelly Mcbeth, an Austin-based legislative strategist for natural resources, will present the program. Only three meetings left in 2009. Please continue to support the DFW Chapter and the program presenters. As a final reminder, it would help us with meeting arrangements if you make an advance reservation by Friday July 10, per the instructions in the newsletter. The meeting cost \$30 with advance reservation and \$35 at the door.
