- 2. The vehicle/vessel must be entered as abandoned into the Law Enforcement Information Network (LEIN.)
- 3. Requests received prior to 25 days from the date of notice will be denied.
- 4. The person applying for the TR-52L Abandoned Vehicle/Vessel Bill of Sale form on behalf of the towing company, custodian or police agency must sign and date the application.
- 5. All information must be legible and complete. Incomplete requests will be denied. Please allow 10 business days for processing.
