THE YAMAHA MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP

The Yamaha Music Foundation, Japan through its associate Schools in Asia have launched the "Yamaha Music Scholarship in Asia" in 2000.

Numerous scholarships have been awarded to full-time music students in China, Indonesia, Malaysia, Singapore, Taiwan and Thailand.

The Music Scholarship is aimed at developing music talents in Asia. It provides financial assistance to students pursuing full-time diploma/degree courses in music at local or overseas educational institutions

THE SCHEME

The Yamaha Music Scholarship is aimed at developing music talents in Singapore. It provides financial assistance to students pursuing full-time diploma/degree courses in music at local or overseas educational institutions.

NATURE OF ASSISTANCE

The scholarship award will be to the value of up to ¥300,000 (approximately S\$3,800 may be shared up to 3 successful candidates). The money may be used for any purpose that is related to the advancement of music studies.

WHO MAY APPLY

Application are open to all nationalities

Applicants will be assessed, according to the following general criteria:

- i a good track record in music education/ activities
- ii potential and commitment to contribute to the local music and arts scene
- iii although merit is primary, the financial background of the applicant may be taken into consideration

ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

Preference will be given to applicants who have already secured a place in an approved educational institution. Male applicants must have gained exemption from the Ministry of Defence for deferment of National Service prior to the onset of their courses.

HOW TO APPLY

- 1) Complete the attached application form, which should be countersigned by your college or faculty head.
- 2) Prepare for the audition with 2 pieces of music (must be contrasting pieces) to be performed solo by you, or solo with piano accompaniment.
