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#### The Commission

The West Bengal Madrasah Service Commission Act, 2008 (West Bengal Act XXV of 2008) enacted by Notification No. 1605L dated 22.10.2008 came into force with effect from 22.10.2008 for the purpose of recruitment of Teachers including Headmasters/Headmistresses of recognized non-Government aided Jr.High/High/Higher Secondary and Senior Madrasahs in West Bengal. Afterwards, the recruitment of non-teaching staff including Librarians has been entrusted with the Commission by amendment of the Act.

The Madrasah Service Commission selects persons for appointment to the posts of Teachers and will soon select non-teaching staff in Madrasahs in West Bengal. A Teacher under the Act means an Assistant Teacher or any other person holding a teaching post in a Madrasah recognized as such by the Board or the Council, as the case may be, and includes the Headmaster/Headmistress, but shall not include the Assistant Headmaster or Assistant Headmistress or the teacher holding a post against short term vacancy caused by deputation, leave or lien.

Advertisement inviting applications for 5<sup>th</sup> State Level Selection Test,2011 showing tentative vacancies mediumwise, subjectwise, categorywise and genderwise is made. Qualified candidates to the extent of not exceeding 1.5 times of the final vacancies declared are called for Personality Test, Provided further that if the marks at the last Position of the qualified list of candidates shall be same for more than one candidate, all such candidates at that position shall be called for the Personality Test.

Panel is prepared to the extent of 1.00 times of such final vacancies and a Waiting List is prepared to the extent of 0.10 time of the final vacancies declared.

## INFORMATION BRIEF FOR THE 5<sup>TH</sup> STATE LEVEL SELECTION TEST FOR APPOINMENT TO THE POST OF ASSISTANT TEACHERS IN RECOGNISED NON-GOVT.AIDED MADRASAHS

The West Bengal Madrasah Service Commission is going to hold the 5<sup>th</sup> State Level Selection Test 2011 or, appointment to the Post of Assistant Teacher in recognized Non-Govt. aided Madrasahs in West Bengal in terms of the Provisions of the West Bengal Madrasah Service Commission Act, 2008. & related State Government Orders.

- A. (1) ELIGIBILITY
  - (2) AGE As per Advertisement published
  - (3) MEDIUM OF WRITTEN EXAMINATION

#### B. MODE OF SELECTION

**Mode of Selection:** Eligible candidates will have to appear at a Written Test comprising 2 (Two) Parts. Questions in Part I are designed to test the knowledge of the candidates in the relevant subject/subjects for which the candidates will sit for the examination under prescribed syllabus. Questions in Part II will focus on (i) Child Development and Pedagogy (ii) the elements of language, grammar and comprehension abilities of the language opted by the candidate.

- (i) For Assistant Teachers (H/PG & Pass Category): The examination of Paper II will be of 90 minutes' duration will carry 90 marks. The candidates will have to darken the circle with black ball point pen for correct response for each item on the a specific OMR sheet provided for the purpose.
- The examination of Paper- I (Subject Test as mentioned) will be of 90 minutes' duration will carry 60 marks and contain 30 short/descriptive type questions in all subjects, except Biological Science (H/PG), to be answered on the question booklet provided for the purpose. In Biological Science (H/PG), there will be 10 questions in each group of Botany, Zoology & Physiology carrying 02 marks in each.
- (ii) For Assistant Teachers (Undergraduate Category): The examination of Paper-II will be of 120 minutes' duration will carry 150 marks. The candidates will have to darken the circle with black ball point pen for correct response for each item on the a specific OMR sheet provided for the purpose. There will be no Paper-I Examination for UG category.

**Personality Test**: Personality Test letter will be issued to the selected candidates on the basis of academic score and marks obtained in Paper I (including score in Training & Co-curricular activities for Undergraduate category) to the extent of not exceeding 1.5 times of the advertised final reported vacancies Mediumwise, Subjectwise & Genderwise. All candidates will be considered against General (unreserved) vacancies in terms of existing Govt. order (s) in Minority Affairs and Madrasah Education Department, Govt. of West Bengal.

There will be no negative marking. COMPILATION OF THE MARKS OF PART I (Subject Test) SHALL BE DONE ONLY FOR THOSE CANDIDATES WHO WILL SECURE THE QUALIFYING MARKS (60%) IN PAPER-II (OMR/MCQ). HOWEVER NO RELAXATION SHALL BE ALLOWED TO THE CANDIDATES.

**THE QUALIFYING MARKS IN PAPER-I (Subject Test) is 40% (FORTY PERCENT).** Relaxable on reasonable grounds Subject wise, Medium wise and Category wise under the provisions of rules of The West Bengal Madrasah Service Commission . For Pass and Honourse Category Marks obtained in Paper –II shall not be added for preparation of final merit list.

No mark-sheet shall be issued to the candidates. **Answer sheets will be preserved for six months after publication of the Panel and the Waiting List.** 

For being considered as belonging to Physically Challenge (PH) categories only the certificates issued by the competent authorities in West Bengal will be treated as valid document. **Candidates belonging to such categories from other States may appear as General Category candidates only.** The code list for PC Categories is provided for use by the candidates while filling up the application forms.

There shall be no re-evaluation/scrutiny of answer scripts, nor shall any request for perusal of answer scripts by the candidates be entertained. No mark-sheet shall be issued to the candidates. Answer sheets will be preserved as per rules after publication of the Panel and the Waiting List.

**Age:** Minimum: 20 years as on 01.01.2012 (i.e. not born after 01.01.1992)

Maximum: 40 years as on 01.01.2012 (i.e. not born before 01.01.1972)

Relaxable upto 55 years of age for approved teaching and non-teaching staff in recognized non-Govt. aided Madrasahs / Schools and Sr. Madrasahs approved by the West Bengal Board of Madrasah Education/West Bengal Board of Secondary Education / West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education.

**Medium of instruction in the Madrasah:** . Candidates applying for Madrasah with particular language as medium must have that language of the medium as first or second or third language at any of the Secondary level or Higher Secondary level or must have succeeded at any subsequent higher level of education in that subject.

Tentative Date & Time of Test: Mid of May,2012 at the allotted Centers all over the State for paper I & paper II (Time: 12.00 Noon to 15.00P.M. & for undergraduate Category: 12.00 Noon to 14.00 P.M. Visually handicapped candidates shall be allowed 15 minutes extra time and separate sitting arrangement shall be made for them.

**Medium of Answers:** Questions will be set in English & Bengali. Answers to be given either in English or Bengali except in language papers.

**Fees for examination:** Application Form & Brochure: Rs. 250/- for General candidates, for Physically Challenged (PH) Rs. 100/- and for female candidates Rs.100/-

Syllabus: Syllabus of each subject is available in the commission's website www.wbmsc.com

Date of collection of Application Form: 29.02.2012 to 15.03.2012 during Banking hours.

Date of Submission of Application Form duly filled in: 29.02.2012 to 16.03.2012 during Banking hours.

Purchase and submission of application form must be from and to the same designated Bank (United Bank of India Branch).

**Note:** Admission to the Test is purely provisional subject to verification of the candidate's eligibility at various stages.

#### C. THE SCHEDULE OF THE TEST

- (i) For Assistant Teachers (Pass, Hons./PG categories): The Test shall be held in Mid of May, 2012 in One Sessions all over West Bengal. The Session will commence at 12 Noon. When Both Question Booklets for Paper I and Paper II will be handed over to the candidates. The completed Question Booklets for Paper II are to be answered first and will be collected by the invigilators exactly at 13.30 P.M. The completed Question Booklets for Paper I are to be answered next and will be collected at 15.00 P.M. when the final bell will be rung. (VISUALLY HANDICAPPED CANDIDATES SHALL BE ALLLOWED 15 MINS EXTRA TIME AND SEPARATE SITTING ARRANGEMENT SHALL BE MADE FOR THEM).
- (ii) For Assistant Teachers (Undergraduate Category): The Test shall be held in Mid of May, 2012 in one sessions all over West Bengal. The First Session will commence at 12 Noon. when Question Booklets for Paper(OMR/MCQ) will be handed over to the candidates. The Completed Question Booklets for Paper are to be answered first and will be collected by the invigilators exactly at 14.00 P.M. (VISUALLY HANDICAPPED CANDIDATES SHALL BE ALLOWED 10 MINS. EXTRA TIME AND SEPARATE SITTING ARRANGEMENT SHALL BE MADE FOR THEM).
- **D. FORM COLLECTION AND LAST DATE**: As per advertisement published. Application Money shall not be refunded under any circumstances. Application not in the prescribed format or incomplete or unsigned or not received through the designated Bank branches of the concerned areas or received after the last date shall not be entertained and shall be rejected.
- **E Separate Panel & related Waiting List** in each subject and each Medium will be prepared against the final vacancies reported from the concerned Madrasahs in the State.
- F. TEST CENTRES: Actual Test Centres (Venue) for Written Examination will be decided solely

by the Madrasah Service Commission and will be communicated to the <u>eligible</u> candidates through their mailing addresses by issuing Admit Cards in due course. Request for change of Centre (Venue) shall not be entertained under any circumstances.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE EMPANELLED CANDIDATES SHALL BE DONE THROUGH COUNSELLING DEPENDING ON HIS/HER COMBINED RANK AGAINST THEIR EMPANELLED CATEGORY IN THE COMBINED MERIT LIST PREPARED ON THE BASIS OF THE REPORTED DECLARED FINAL VACANCIES TO BE PUBLISHED IN WEBSITE WELL AHEAD OF COUNSELLING IN THE COMMISSION'S WEBSITE.

A CANDIDATE CAN APPLY FOR ONLY IN ONE SUBJECT AND ONLY IN ONE CATEGORY OF POST i.e. FOR PASS OR FOR HONS./PG OR FOR UNDERGRADUATE (UG) POST. ANY CANDIDATE FOUND TO HAVE SUBMITTED APPLICATION VIOLATING THE AFORESAID CRITERIA WOULD BE DISQUALIFIED. IF DETECTED AT ANY STAGE, AND MIGHT BE DEBARRED FROM FUTURE EXAMINATONS.

THE CANDIDATURE IS LIABLE TO BE CANCELLED AT ANY STAGE IN THE EXAMINATION PROCESS OR IN FUTURE, IF IT IS FOUND BY PRACTISING FROUD/MISINFORMATION/FALSE DECLARATION PROVIDED BY THE CANDIDATE.

- **G. Disqualification for Candidature:** (1) No person shall be eligible for selection for appointment to the post of Teacher in any Madrasah within its territorial jurisdiction unless he is a citizen of India.
- (2) No person shall be eligible for selection for appointment to-the post of Teacher in any Madrasah if he has accepted or offered dowry in any form at the time of his marriage or his son's or daughter's marriage.
- **H.** Disqualification of in-Service Teachers in the same Category of Post: Candidates once appointed through the West Bengal Madrasah Service Commission are not eligible to apply during a period of two years to the post of a teacher in the same category of Post from the date of last appointment in any Madrasah.
- **I. Bar on Recommendation :** The Madrasah Service Commission shall not recommend the name of a person:
- (a) who, at the time of submission of application or after submission of application, is appointed to the post of a Teacher in a School or Madrasah on the basis of recommendation made by the West Bengal School Service Commission or the West Bengal Madrasah Service Commission and continues his service as such Teacher, but has not completed continuous three years' approved service in the said post.
- (b) who, while in-service, having obtained required degree for being considered for the post applied for fails to submit before the Madrasah Service Commission the requisite document of his/her approved study leave, or any kind of leave for the purpose of relevant higher studies, or permission from the appropriate authority for prosecuting the studies for the said degree.
- **J. Additional essential qualification of candidate for the Post of Teacher**: **(1)** A candidate willing to be selected as a teacher in any Madrasah, having Bengali or English or Urdu as the Medium of instruction, must have Bengali or English or Urdu, as the case may be, as first or second or third language or as a subject at any of the Secondary or Higher Secondary or Graduation or Post Graduation level-(a) at Secondary level of the Board or equivalent; or
  - (b) at High Secondary level of the Council or equivalent; or
  - (c) at any subsequent higher level of education in that language Paper.

#### GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Before submitting the Application Form, the candidate should satisfy himself/herself that he/she fulfills all the eligibility conditions as laid down in the advertisement to avoid rejection of the Application Form. Academic Qualifications (Degree/Hons./PG/B.T./B.Ed/B.P.Ed./JBT etc) obtained after submission of the application form shall not be entertained.
- 2. Candidates having obtained at least B.A./B.Sc./B.Com./ Kamil Pass/Hons. Degree is eligible to apply for Pass or Hons./ PG Vacancies. Candidates having Passed at least H.S./Fazil/equivalent is eligible to apply for undergraduate (UG) vacancies.
- 3. Admit Card for the Written Examination for State Level Selection Test (SLST) indicating the Venue (Centre of Written Examination) will be despatched to all the eligible candidates well ahead of the commencement of the Written Examination by RMS Registered or Speed Post in order to ensure that the Admit Cards reach the candidates in time. The date of holding the SLST will be announced in the important daily newspapers and Commission's website www.wbmsc.com.
- 4. The acceptance or rejection of candidature of each candidate shall be published in the Commission's website approximately 2 (two) weeks before the commencement of the Written Examination.
- 5. If any candidate does not receive the Admit Card within one week before the Written Examination, he/she must immediately contact the office of the Commission. On receipt of the Admit Card the candidate should check it very carefully and bring the discrepancy/discrepancies, if any, to the notice of the Commission. The candidate must bring the Admit Card to the Examination Hall to secure admission for the Written Examination.
- 6. Candidates should carefully note that this permission for appearing at the Written Examination is **provisional**. The decision of the authority as to the eligibility or otherwise of the candidate for admission to the Written Examination shall be final.
- 7. Candidates must abide by the instructions as may be specified on the cover page of the Examination Booklet or any other instructions as may be printed in the Admit Card or may be given by the Officer-in-Charge of the Centre.
- 8. No T.A. will be paid to the candidate for appearing at the Examination Centre.
- 9. Use of Calculator/Mobile Phone/Log Tables (other than any instruction provided in the Examination Booklet) is not permitted.
- 10. A candidate found **canvassing in any form and/or guilty of indiscipline** in the Examination Hall or using unfair means of any nature or noting down the question, except on Answer Sheet, shall liable to be disqualified from this Examination and also in future Examinations.
- 11. If a candidate writes his/her name or puts any special mark at any place in the Examination booklet, which may disclose, in any way, the identity of the candidate, he/she will render himself/herself liable to disqualification.
- 12. Any dispute will be subject to the jurisdiction of the Calcutta High Court only.
- 13. Incomplete Application Form in regard to submission of relevant information will be rejected forthwith.
- 14. Incorrect/False information will lead to cancellation of candidature if detected before or after the Examination and appropriate action will be initiated, even if detected after publication of the Panel.
- 15. Attested copies(Attested by Gazetted officer/HEAD MASTER/SUPERINTENDENT of all documents relating to items 3,8,12,16,17.1/17.2,21 to 23,[21A (for Hons./PG Category only), 21B (for Pass Category only), 21C (for Physical Education only), 21D (for Work Education only) & 21E (for B.ED/JBT/Co-curricular etc. only)] shall have to be enclosed and stitched with the Application Form. PHOTOGRAPH in ITEM NO.73 in the Application Form is to be Pasted only and the PHOTOGRAPH is not to be stamped or attested.
