- Fill out a separate scholarship application form (attached) for each scholarship.
- Attach all required documents. If you do not attach all required supporting documents, you will be eliminated from consideration.
- Make a copy of your application and attached documents for your files. The application and documents will not be returned.

Deadline - Return the completed scholarship application by: **October 11th, 2012** .

Award Notification - If you are selected as the recipient of a scholarship, you will be notified by phone on October 18th, 2012 .

\$100 USPS Employee / Dependent Scholarship Award

- The applicant must be a full-time UCF/USPS employee seeking a degree and be enrolled for the Fall 2012 semester OR the dependent of a USPS employee who is seeking a degree and be enrolled for the Fall 2012 semester.
- The USPS Employee must have one year of service completed prior to the term for which the award is requested and have not received a USPS Staff Council Award within the previous calendar year.
- The applicant must provide proof of at least one course at UCF.
- The applicant's minimum overall GPA must be 2.5 (attach a copy of your degree audit).
- The applicant must provide a short essay on their goals in pursuing your higher education.
- Consideration will be given to longevity of employment at UCF.

\$100 USPS Employee Savings Incentive Award – UCF Credit Union

- The applicant must be a full-time UCF/USPS employee seeking a degree at UCF or a community college for the Fall 2012 semester.
- The USPS Employee must have one year of service completed prior to the term for which the award is requested and have not received a USPS Staff Council Award within the previous calendar year.
- The applicant must provide proof of at least one course at UCF or a community college and have a minimum overall GPA of 2.5 (attach copy of your degree audit).
- The applicant must provide a short essay on their goals in pursuing your higher education.
- Consideration will be given to longevity of employment at UCF.

\$250 USPS Employee and Employee's Dependent Scholarship Award

- The applicant must be a full-time UCF/USPS employee seeking a degree and be enrolled for the Fall 2012 semester OR the dependent of a USPS employee who is seeking a degree and be enrolled for the Fall 2012 semester.
- The USPS Employee must have one year of service completed prior to the term for which the award is requested and have not received a USPS Staff Council Award within the previous calendar year.
- If the applicant is the employee, proof of enrollment for at least three courses at UCF must be provided and they must have a minimum overall GPA of 3.0. If the applicant is a dependent, proof of enrollment for at least two courses at UCF must be provided and they must have a minimum overall GPA of 3.0.
- The applicant must attach a copy of their degree audit.
- Dependents demonstrate dependency as determined by the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid for 2011-2012).
- The applicant must provide a short essay on their goals in pursuing your higher education.
- Consideration will be given to longevity of employment at UCF.

\$100 USPS Employee Spirit Scholarship Award

This scholarship will be awarded to the submission that best exemplifies the Spirit of UCF.

- The applicant must be a full-time UCF/USPS employee seeking a degree and be enrolled for the Fall 2012 semester.
- The USPS Employee must have one year of service completed prior to the term for which the award is requested.
- The applicant must provide proof of at least one course at UCF with a minimum overall GPA of 2.5 (attach copy of your degree audit).
- The submission can consist of various forms of art (essay, photograph, poem, music, video, etc.). The submission **MUST** fit within the confines of a 9 inch x 12 inch mailing envelope. The submission will not be returned.
- Please include a short description about the piece and how it captures the Spirit of UCF.
