

- Take US 10 W or US 27 N and exit at the second Clare exit (old US 27)
- Turn left (west) on Colonville Rd and go 1 block.
 Turn right at light on old US 27 (S. Clare Ave)
- Turn right at light on old US 27 (S. Clare Ave Camp Rotary is 8 miles on right side

FROM THE NORTH

- Take US 27 South and exit at the third Harrison exit (old US 27)
- Turn left (east) on Mannsiding Rd and go 1/2 mile.
 Turn right on old US 27 (S. Clare Ave)
- Camp Rotary is 1 mile on left side




