Your legal duties

The law requires you to obtain a licence from WorkSafe before undertaking certain workplace activities.

From July 2007 new safety laws based on a national approach agreed to by all States will apply to anyone working with high risk equipment.

The 'Licence to Perform High Risk Work' will replace the existing 'ticket' to operate high risk equipment. A ticket may be an 'old style' Certificate (issued pre-1995) or a Certificate of Competency.

The more rigorous licensing system will better recognise the skills and responsibilities of people operating high risk equipment

A Licence will be issued for five years and is valid in every Australian State and Territory, enabling people to operate high risk equipment under consistent standards everywhere in Australia.

Gaining your Licence to operate high risk machinery means that your employer, fellow workers and the general public can feel confident that you are capable of operating a forklift in a range of normal working environments without endangering yourself or the health and safety of other persons.

Only individuals that are 18 years of age or older can apply for a 'Licence to Perform High Risk Work'

At no time is an unlicensed trainee operator to be on a Forklift unless under the supervision (sight & sound) of a Licensed person

LOG BOOK RECOMENDATIONS

It is highly recommended that all unlicensed individuals operating high risk machinery such as forklifts, cranes, elevated work platforms and earthmoving machinery have evidence of their driving time operating the machinery.

This can be achieved by filling in a log book each time you are driving the machinery.

What is a Log Book for?

It tracks the hours you have operated the forklift (or other types of high risk machinery) under supervision and to keep a record of the training completed.

Once you have successfully completed your assessment it will be good practice to continue to fill out your log book.

Should there be a workplace accident, Worksafe will require evidence of the driver's competence and your log book will prove your time for each machine that you operate.

TRAINING PROCEDURE

A licensed operator **MUST supervise** the trainee operator at all times when they are operating the machine until the trainee operator is licensed.

Note: Supervision means within sight and sound

Note: Licensed person is an operator who holds a current Worksafe Licence or National Competency.

The **Log Book** must be filled in by the trainee operator, showing time spent, date and signature of the licensed person supervising. This must be completed each time the trainee operator is operating the machine.

At no time is an unlicensed trainee operator to be on machinery unless under supervision of a Licensed person.

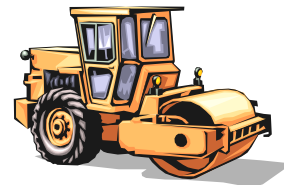
